

Sunday Nov 8th

Begins light air from W at 1 commenced
boiling at 5 finished whale sail but saw nothing
out Fin Back at sundown took in sail and
commenced boiling Mid the same at daylight
Made sail and steered S E at 10 A.M. saw Whales
Several and struck two thus ends the Whales
Running like the devil Lat 36.44

Monday Nov 9th

Begins fine weather at 1 took one of the Whales
to the ship put up the Helm and run off
to the other Whale at 5 took him to the ship
and commenced cutting at 9 finished one Whale
and set the Watch Middle part employed
in cleaning away the Head at daylight a
strong breeze and plenty of rain at 8 cleared
off but the Whale in and commenced
boiling do ends the day saw Whales but
did not lower spoke the Chary of a Bedford
Capt Ricketson with 800 (200) sperm Lat 36.50

Tuesday Nov 10th

Begins a strong breeze and began employed
in boiling and Building a Broom room
and starting Broom at 5 P.M. spoke the
Ship Hercules 1200 (600) sperm
Latter part part fine weather saw nothing
thus ends employed in boiling Lat 37.08 15.50

Wednesday Nov 11th

Begins Light air from E saw plenty
Fin Backs at 5 saw 2 Ships steering
to the S.W. at sundown took in sail
and for to the S employed in boiling
and throwing down oil Latter part the same
thus ends two ships in sight Lat 37.30

Thursday Nov 12th

Begins fine weather Several seen and struck
a Whale took him to the ship and cut him in
at 5 P.M. spoke the Ship Martha of Freedom
Capt Whelden 2500 blbs in wanting one Whale
and to fill salt him five barrels of Beef & 2
of Pork & 2 of Flour and a Sack of Molasses
Received from him 1 Blubber Hook & 2 Sperm
and 262 feet of Carr at daylight began to
Boil ends the same employed in boiling and
throwing down thus ends Lat 37.30

Friday Nov 13th

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All this day fine weather all hands employed in
Boiling and throwing down saw nothing but fine looks
thus ends the day the weather in sight
and several lots boiling Lat 37.45

Saturday Nov 14th

Begins fine weather employed in throwing
down Boiling Middle part the same at
7 A.M. finished boiling Latter part employed in
take Mending Boat and setting up pipes
thus ends saw nothing but Benbacks before
ships in sight Lat 36.58

Sunday Nov 15th

Begins fine weather Light air from W
saw on different ^{tracks} saw plenty Fin Backs
but no Whales at sunset shortened sail and
lay to the South Middle and Latter part
a gale from S.W. with plenty of rain
employed in Bottery up ship thus
ends the day saw nothing No Obs

Monday Nov 16th

Begins with a Gale from S.W. at 6
P.M. none ship to the S.W. Middle part
the same ends a Gale all Hands employed
in cleaning Broom saw nothing Lat 36.39
