

Tuesday February 2nd

Begins a gale, as usual from S
standing to the Eastward under double reef S
sails and courses employed in mending Mizzen
T sails at sunset took in Fore and Mizzen
Topsails at daylight set the Fore and Mizzen
Topsails double reefed Ends the day standing
to the Eastward saw nothing Lat 29.54 Long 109.46.

Wednesday 3rd

Begins with a moderate gale as usual from
SSE standing Easterly under short sail at sunset
took in Fore and Mizzen Topsails at daylight set
them again Ends the day saw nothing Lat 29.26-109.54
Long 109.54

Thursday 4th

Begins a fresh breeze from S squared the yards
and steered NNE at sunset took in sail and
sailed to the north heading E at daylight made
sail and steered to the North at 10
saw the ship Maria Theresa Tugboat
of New Bedford 800 bbls of whale oil
so ends the day Lat 28.48

Friday 5th

All these 24 hours a fresh breeze from
SSE working to the S in Company with
the Theresa saw nothing Lat 28.16

Saturday 6th

All this day strong breezes in Company
with the Theresa saw nothing Lat 27.19

Sunday 7th

All this day a fresh breeze from S and
a thick smoke saw nothing so ends the
day in Company with the Theresa Lat 26.30

Monday 8th

All this day a fresh breeze from S and
thick smoky weather saw nothing so ends
the day the Theresa in Company Lat 25.46
Long 109.48

Tuesday February 9th

Begins a fresh breeze and thick smoky
weather Middle and Latter part much the
same so ends the Theresa in Company Lat 25.05

Wednesday 10th

All these 24 hours strong gales and thick
overcast weather stood on different tracks Latter
part heard a report from a boat near for Whales
but made nothing of them so ends Theresa in Company
Lat 24.24

Thursday 11th

Begins strong gales and thick overcast weather
at 5 P.M. heard the cry of three she Bears
3 times but heard nothing more Lat part the
same as the first at daylight a merchant ship
passed us steering NNE Ends nothing in sight Lat 24.25

Friday 12th

All this 24 hours fresh breezes and thick
weather stood on different tracks but saw
nothing so ends the day Lat by Obs 23.01

Saturday 13th

Begins a fresh breeze and clear stood on
different tracks but nothing Latter part much
the same so ends the day Lat 23.44 = 110.54

Sunday 14th

Begins a fresh breeze and clear middle part
the same Latter part cloudy and thick weather
so ends the day saw nothing Lat by Obs 23.42

Monday 15th

Begins a fresh breeze and cloudy standing to the
SE at sunset double reefed the T sails and work in the
chain sail and still middle part the same Latter part
quite overcast and smoky stood to the SE saw nothing Lat 23.54
Long 111.00

Tuesday 16th

Begins light air from SSE standing SE at 2 P.M.
saw some kind of whales going to the SE as the
lead was after them at sunset shortened sail
Latter part a strong breeze stood on different tracks
saw nothing so ends the day Lat 24.25 = 111.26
