Commences a strong breeze from S.E. and stands
at 2 P.M. more ship and then to the E. at sunset
shorten the Main sail and Gills at daylight
set single reef I sails and Commences Ende
much the same saw nothing Lat 25.41 Long 109.23

Tuesday March 2nd

Commences strong wind and thick overcast weather
standing to the E. at 4 o'clock took in Main
sail at daylight set double reef I sails
saw a Merchant Ship steering to the W.
Ends while I sails and Commences clear nothing Lat 25.41 Long 109.36

Wednesday March 3rd

Commences a strong breeze and Clear standing
to the E. at 4 o'clock on took in Main
gills and Spraker and double reef the
I sails at sunset took in I and M
I sails latter part stood to the E. single
reef Top sails and Commences at 11 o'clock saw 2
Large sperm whales low and strike
Ends the same Lat 25.55 = 110.15

Thursday March 4th

Begins a strong breeze and a large
silly at 1/2 took the sail to the
Ship arose round and began to beat
at at sunset lashed down from the
sheet at daylight Commences luffing
again at 10 finished and made sail to Ende
the clear nothing Lat 25.22 Long 110.07

Friday March 5th

Begins a fresh breeze and Clear standing
to the S.W. under short sail at 4 hours
the report from Aft of whales but
heard nothing more supposed it to be
a jumper at sunset took in sail and
more to the E. middle part the same
at 9 A.M. set double reef I sails Ends the
same employed in luffing saw nothing Lat 25.32

Saturday March 6th

Begins a strong breeze and Clear standing to the S.W.
under short sail employed in luffing at sunset took
in sail at middle part Lay to the E. at 2 A.M. finished
luffing latter part stood to the S.W. so ends the day
saw nothing Lat 25.42 Long 109.37

Sunday March 7th

Begins with a fresh breeze and Smoky stood
to the N.E. under short sail at dusk took in
sail middle part the same at daylight light breeze
and Clear made all sail at 4 saw a whale we killed
a Sulphur Bottom Sperm has boats but it proved
to be a fin Brink lower fine weather Lat 25.14 Long 109.50

Monday March 8th

10 Commences light breeze and Clear from S.W. more
ship and stand to the E. all sail set at 4 o'clock
unbent on hand a fine top sail and Fine Top sail
sail at sundown shortened sail and luffed the
I.E. middle part the same at daylight made all
sail Ends the same fine clear nothing all hands employed
in showing down sail Lat 24.49

Tuesday March 9th

Commences light breeze from S.W. standing in to
the S.W. at dusk shortened sail and more ship to
the S. middle part wind hauled to the S. more ship and
lay to the W. Ends the same fine weather saw nothing to the

Wednesday March 10th

Begins a fresh breeze from S. and overcast weather standing
to the E. under I sails and Commences at sunset double reef
on shorten the M. sail and Jills middle part
the same at daylight made all sail on deck
the yards and sheet to the W. so ends the day 1 sail
in sight Lat

Thursday March 11th

Begins fine weather at 1 P.M. spoke the
Ship Maria Ann speaking at sunset shortened
sail latter part fine weather stood to the W.
saw nothing so ends the day Lat 25.17 Long 108.57
