

Friday March 11th

Commence light air from S and clear stand at all sail
set at dark shortened sail and lay to the W at day
light made all sail ends the same fine weather
steering S W saw nothing Lat 24.54 Long 109.00

Saturday March 12th

Begins light air and pleasant steering S E at dark
shortened sail and lay to the E at daylight made all sail
ends the same fine weather steering to the
W saw nothing Lat by Obs

Sunday March 13th

Begins fine weather steering to the E at sunset
took in S & sails M sail and gills at stand
to the S E middle part the same at daylight made
sail and went to the W ends the same saw nothing Lat 24.30

Monday March 14th

Begins with a fine breeze and clear standing to the E
at dark shortened sail and lay to the E at daylight
set M sail and gills and turned one reef on
the M T sail ends the same saw nothing Lat 24.30
Long 110.19

Tuesday March 15th

Begins a fresh breeze standing to the E at dark
shortened sail at daylight made sail ends a
strong breeze and going clouds standing to the
S E saw a Grampus Lat 24.25 Long 110.42

Wednesday March 16th

Begins a fresh breeze standing to the E at 3 double
reefed the T sails and took in the M sail and
gills at 8 took in Mizen Top sail at dark took in
S T sail and down ship to the W at daylight
set double reef T sails better part took in S
and Mizen T sails ends the same blowing a
gale from S E saw nothing Lat 24.48

Thursday March 17th

Begins a gale from S E laying to the S E
at 12 P M took in fore sail and close
up the M T sail middle part the same
better part set the T sail and ends Lat 25.08

Friday March 18th

Begins a heavy gale from S E standing to the S W
at 11 P M wind hailed to the S E the same ship
heading S E ends the same a very heavy swell and
flowing a heavy gale Lat by Obs 24.36

Saturday March 19th

Begins a heavy gale from S W and a large swell
from S E ship heading S E at 2 P M took in the
Bow Boat ship under close reef M T sail and
Spencers latter part more moderate set double reef T sail
ends saw 1. Finlark Lat by Obs 24.54 Long 109.16

Sunday March 20th

Begins a strong breeze from S W and a heavy swell ship
standing to the S E at dark took in sail at daylight set
T sails and Mizen and down ship ends much the same
got out the Bow Boat saw nothing Lat by Obs 25.04

Monday March 21st

Commence a fine breeze and overcast weather set the light
sails and down E T at dark shortened sail and lay
to the S E at daylight made sail and steered to the
W W ends the same saw nothing Lat 25.33 Long 110.55

Tuesday March 22nd

Begins a fresh breeze and good weather steering S E at
5 P M saw a Breach between a jumper at dark
took in sail and lay to the S E at daylight made sail
and steered to the W hoisted the pumps out and
blown the Mill Rovers to ends saw nothing Lat 25.16

Wednesday March 23rd

Begins a fresh breeze from S standing E S E under
short sail at 3 P M sent a Ketch to the S E
at dark took in sail and lay to the E middle
part the same at daylight set double reef T sails
ends the same standing to the W saw nothing Lat 25.20

Thursday March 24th

Begins a strong breeze and a large swell standing to the S
all hands employed in ^{taking} faging & mices at dark took in sail
at daylight set double reef T sails ends the same standing
to the W saw nothing Lat by Obs 25.23
