

Ship Montpelier Cruising
Friday March 16th

Commences a gale as usual standing to the E under double reef T sails at dusk took in F and M Top sails and lay to the E latter part stood to the W under short sail at 9 saw a ship standing to the W ends the same sail in sight sighted

Saturday March 27th

Begins more moderate set all sail & ship in sight at 3 P.M. spoke her it proved to be the Crossack of Rochester Capt Delano & months out of the V.L. at dusk took in sail and lay to the E latter part fine weather no whales the Crossack in company so ends the day set by 24.16

Sunday March 28th

Commences fine weather stand to the Crossack in company Brought from Capt Delano 3 bbls of Beef and one of Flour sold him one Fiddle and 6 Muskets at dusk took in sail and lay to the E latter part fine weather stand to the W so ends saw nothing set 23.58

Monday March 29

Begins fine weather stand on different heads saw nothing at dusk shortened sail and lay to the E latter part stood to the W all sail set employed in mending T sail so ends saw nothing set 24.03

Tuesday March 30th

Begins fine weather stand to the E employed in repairing T sail at dusk shortened sail and lay to the E middle the same latter part stood to the W saw nothing open employed in mending T sail set 23.57 109.95

Wednesday March 31st

Begins fine weather stand to the E employed in putting shudding sail Jack and Sevel Blocks at dusk shortened sail latter part a moderate gale stand W under short sail so ends one sail in sight set by 23.55

Thursday April 1st

Begins a moderate gale from S standing E at dusk took in S and M T sails & ship in sight middle part the same lay to the E a Baking latter part stood to the W so ends set 24

Friday April 2nd

All this day strong gale from Southern stand on different heads under short sail saw nothing but one sail so ends the day set 24.16

Saturday April 3rd

First part of these 24 hours strong gale from S stand to the E under short sail - middle and latter part much the same so ends

Sunday April 4th

Begins a fine breeze on Clear stand on different heads saw nothing latter part light airs on Calm so ends

Monday April 5th

Begins with light airs from S at dusk took in T & sails and stand the M sail at 3 had a heavy Tempest on T and T sails of men took in F and M T sails and clear says the M ends with some rain wind to the N and E stand W under Reef T sails saw nothing

Tuesday April 6th

Begins with a fresh breeze from West E stand to the W at dusk took in sail and lay to the N W latter part fine weather stand to the W all sail set saw nothing set 23.16 109.95

Wednesday April 7th

All these 24 hours a fine breeze from E stand to the W mid part lay to the E latter part stood to the W all sail set saw nothing the watch employed in putting Royals on T shudding sail gear so ends 23.25 108.33
