

Sunday April 13th 1841

Begins fine pleasant weather light air from S
All the Boats in Chase of Whales started at
one being the fore off did not get post at 8 P.M.
gave up the chase without a going at 10 at
dark took in the light sails in I am started
to the S.W. Latter much the same light air
and Calms saw nothing Lat 22.55 Long 108.59

Monday April 14th

Begins light air and Calm ship heading S.E.
at 1 P.M. saw a breeze on the weather saw
nothing more of it pronounced it a Squall
at dark took in the light sails from E
start to the S.E. Latter part light air and Calm
1 ship in sight 20 miles Lat 23.18

Tuesday April 15th

Begins a dead Calm 1 ship in sight at dark
took in the light sails middle part a light
breeze from E. Ends a strong breeze from
S at 8 spoke the ship Leonidas 700 Spinn
ends in Company Lat 23.26

Wednesday April 16th

Begins a strong breeze from S standing
to the S.W. in Company with the Leonidas
at dark took in sail 2 ships in sight
Latter part a strong breeze spoke the ship
Maver Delano N.B. 850 bbls spin 10 ends
the day 3 ships in sight

Thursday April 17th

Begins a fresh breeze from S at 3 P.M. spoke
the ship Adeline Gray 600 Spinn on
ago 1000 the Herald Devol Fairhaven 900 bbls
50 of spin at dark took in sail and started
E.N.E. all night at daylight made sail ends
standing to the S.E. ends in sight

Friday April 18th

Begins a fresh breeze from S start to the E at 4 P.M. spoke
the ship South Boston Crosswell Fairhaven 650 bbls oil
on 450 spin at dark took in sail as usual Latter
part fine weather at 7 a.m. spoke the Herald on took
her Latter ends pleasant 3 ships in sight

Saturday April 19th

Begins light air and Calm at dark spoke the Adeline
on S Boston and took three Latter middle part
Calm Latter part light air from S.W. start to the
S.E. 20 ends 2 ships in sight

Sunday April 20th

Begins fine weather 2 ships in sight at dark
shortened sail at daylight made all sail
and start to the S.W. ends the same
nothing in sight Lat 23.06 Long 110.25

Monday April 21st

Begins fine pleasant weather light air from
S start to the S.W. saw nothing at dark
shortened sail on S.W. to the S.W.
Latter part fine weather but no sails in
ends 2 ships in sight saw 2 pinkies Lat 23.33

Tuesday April 22nd

Begins fine pleasant weather start to the
E at 4 P.M. spoke the ship Maria Mosher
Fairhaven 2200 bbls 600 spin Latter light
air and pleasant 2 ships in sight 20 ends
the day on no fish Lat 23.53 Long 110.20

Wednesday April 23rd

Begins light air and pleasant start to the
S.E. on from S.W. at dark took in
the light sail at daylight made all sail at
8 A.M. Laid out for a Sulphur Bottom
Got post and the fore drove ends light
air from W 4 Boats on 1 ship in sight
1 Boat cutting
