

Ship Montpelier From New Holland To Rodriguez
Tuesday June 8th

Begins a fresh breeze from S W ship heading S W
all sail set at dark wind hauled more to the S and
the yards out at the 3rd the standing sail
middle part the same Concludes a strong breeze
from S W Course W by N all sail set Lat 21.16 = 99.39

Wednesday June 9th

Begins a fine breeze from S Course W by N all
sail set middle part light airs at S W Concludes
a fine breeze from S E struck a Porpoise and
lost him So Ends the day Lat 20.50 = 97.31

Thursday June 10th

Begins a fine breeze and pleasant from S E
Course W by N all sail set middle part a fine
breeze from S Concludes a Fresh breeze from S E
Course W by N So Ends the day nothing Lat 20.40 = 95.22

Friday June 11th

Begins a fine breeze from S E Course W by N
at 8 sent out the 3rd the standing sail middle
part light airs from S E Concludes a fine breeze
from S by W hauled in lower standing sail
So Ends the day in making Beam irons for the ship Lat 20.23 = 93.31

Saturday June 12th

Begins a fine breeze from S Course W by N
all sail set the 3rd the on the all yards out
and sent out the standing sail at dark hauled
the chain Royal as usual middle part a
strong breeze and variable from S to E with
rain squalls Ends a steady breeze from S E Course
W by N Sent Fin back Lat 20.00 = 91.22

Sunday June 13th

Begins a fine breeze from S E Course W by N
all sail set middle and latter part much
the same So Ends the day saw
one Fin back Lat 19.57 Long 88.56

Ship Montpelier Towards Rodriguez
Monday June 14th

Begins with light winds from S E Course W all
sail set middle part the same latter part light
airs from S the catch employed in making Ratten ship
So Ends a number Fin Backs in sight Lat 19.35 = 87.31

Tuesday June 15th

Begins with a fine breeze from S by S ship
heading W by N at 8 sent the Main Top Mast standing
sail Course W middle and latter part light
airs and Calms So Ends the day Lat 19.33 = 86.00

Wednesday June 16th

Begins light airs from S E Course W by N all
sail set saw a number Fin back middle part
much the same with a heavy swell at daylight got ready
to Cooper the Oil between decks found it in good
order stowed of again at 9 hauled in strong and plenty
of rain back in standing sails Ends a Gale from S E
Ship under single reef of sails and Course Lat 19.40 = 83.31

Thursday June 17th

Begins a Gale from S E Course W at 8 double
reef and took in the all sail and plenty of Mist
Lockets middle much the same some lightning made
and took in sail as required Ends more moderate
from S at 9 of sails and S 3rd the standing
sail Course both gunwales of the 3rd the
broke took her on deck and repaired Lat 19.38
Long 81.00

Friday June 18th

Begins a fresh breeze and sprightly from S E
Course W took in S 3rd the standing sail middle
part much the same under S sails and
Course Ends a fresh breeze from S by W all
sail set saw nothing Lat 19.29 = 78.49

Saturday June 19th

Begins a strong breeze from S by W Course
W by South all sail set at 8 bent a new
S 3rd the sail middle and latter part
the same saw 1 Fin back Lat 19.49 = 76.19
