Ladies at 5 AM. Calla all hands on deck and
Anchor and went to sea with 4 Cattle on deck
and about 400 Fowl 50 Pumpkins 50 turpins and
12 bushels of Sweet Potatoes at 8 killed one of the
Cattle Latter post employed in Storing Shrimps
Shrimps & Co. So ended the day a dead Calm
Sandy Islands being 3 by 3 miles off

Sunday July 18th

Begins Calm at 1 took a Light breeze from
S.W. saw a ship bound into the Bay had
her anchors set but could not tell what
the word middle post a fine breeze ship
heading W by South Ends much the same
Employed in Cleaning Shells Lot 24, 12

Monday July 19th

Begins with a Light breeze from S.W.
Ship heading S at 7 PM tackled to the N.W.
middle post much the same Ends with
a Light breeze from S.W. standing to the
western side all hands employed in Coopersing
the Oil from Between decks Lot 24, 14 = 41, 55

Tuesday July 20th

Begins fine weather a light breeze from
S.W. standing westerly all hands employed
in Breaking out and Coopersing Oil middle
and Latter posts a strong breeze from S.W.
Course S.W. at daylight split the Fly
Jib at the same time took in the Fore & M
Rogals Ends much the same to Riggs to
to Coopers the oil took in the Bow Port
and put her on the spurs on Thiller to Bear
Lot 25, 17 Long 40, 21

Wednesday July 21st

Begins with a fine breeze from S.E. Course
W.S.W. employed in mending Fly Jib at 1 PM
set the F.T. Mast shudding sail at 5 set Fore &
M royal M.T.G. shudding sail and Fly Jib middle
post much the same Latter post light airs and
Calm Employed in Coopersing oil to Ends Lot 26, 14 = 38, 42

Thursday July 22nd

Begins a dead Calm middle post light airs
from S.W. then to the S.W. Latter post a strong
breeze from S.W. Course W.S.W. double reef T sails
and Course to Ends the day Lot 26, 13 = 38, 21

Friday July 23rd

Begins strong Gale from S Course W.S.W. under
double reef T sails and Course at 1 Bent a new
Long Logwood stay sail at 4 sent down the Royal
yards middle post more moderate set all
sail F.T. Mast shudding sail Ends light
airs from S.E. set shudding sails below
and Hight Course M.R. Van and set the
jib sail to Ends the day Lot 27, 18 = 35, 52

Saturday July 24th

Begins light airs from S.E. Course W.S.W.
all sail set at 4 hauled up S.W. by W middle
and Latter posts the same to Ends the day light
winds from E employed in Ships duty Lot 28, 32
Long 38, 06

Sunday July 25th

Begins light airs and pleasant from E Course
S.W. by W all sail set at 4 killed a Bay Bitter
middle and Latter posts a strong breeze
to Ends the day all sail took in West Port Lot 30, 21
Long 33, 40

Monday July 26th

Begins a fresh breeze from S.E. Course W.S.W.
all sail set middle post the same at 5 set
hauled up W by S Ends light winds from N.W.
Steamer W. should in all the shudding sails
to Ends the day Lot 32, 22 Long 31, 38
