Saturday August 8th

Begins strong Gale and squally at 3 set the Top
sails and at 4 set the ship's heading at E. at 7 had
a heavy squall the rain falling in torrents, double
repeal the Top sails at 10 from weather rain from
W all sail set middle part the dome covered the
Royal Yards and set the sails heading at N. E. at
5 o'clock a dead calm at 6 took a light breeze
from N. E. Ends a strong breeze from N. E. 8
heading N. W. under 2 sails and Courses set 55, 52, 16, 25

Sunday August 9th

at 5 o'clock Commence
Mist on 18th 10

Begins strong Gale from N. E. 8 standing N. W.
under 2 sails and Courses at 4 double reefed the
2 sails middle part closed on to a heavy Gale
broke in sail to close reef 2 and Main Top sails
and Reel fore sail latter part a very heavy Gale from
W. to Ends the day heading Northwesterly under close
reef M. T. sail Lot 53, 34

Monday August 10th

B. m. at 1. 24. 19. 10
6 " 15. 10

Begins a heavy Gale from W. by S at 3 moderate
breeze set close reef 2 T. sail and reefed 2 sail
and stand N. E. W. at 4 set double reefed 2 and
at 5 the sails turned the reef out the 2 sail and
set the Main sail middle part a strong breeze
and squally made sail and took in as required
heading from N. E. 8 to N. E. 8 latter part covered
the Royal Yards Ends a fine breeze from W. by S
all sail set & ship in sight standing about 17
Long 15. 0. 2

Tuesday August 11th

Begins a fresh breeze from N. E. W. covered S. W.
at 6 set the 2 Royal and 2 T. masthead S. W. 3
standing sails Middle part Calm latter part
a light breeze from N. E. W. to
the N. E. one ship in sight breeze Northwesterly
to Ends the day Employed in making a
fine haulage Lot 53, 27 Long 14. 22

Wednesday August 11th

Commence light air and pleasant standing to the
N. E. 8 ship about standing the same at 3 wind
from W. by S. Top mast and Top Gallant standing
sails at 6 passed our shipboard it being the first
ship we have met the Voyage at 7 wind more aft
set lower standing sail middle part the same
Ends a strong breeze from S. E. 8 Course N. E. 8 all
sail set our neighbour in sight about 17. 0. 7
Long 13. 45

Thursday August 12th

Begins a fresh breeze from S. E. 8 Course N. E. 8
all sail set standing sails both sides below and
aloft at 2 our hat men us out of sight middle
part close the first sail more moderate wind
from S. W. Course N. E. 8 by W. 2 W. Lot 30, 26, 11
Long 10. 25
10. 35

Friday August 13th

Begins a fine breeze and pleasant from S. W. Course
N. E. 8 by W. 2 W. all sail set middle part the same
Ends much the same employed in ships duty the 13th

Saturday August 14th

Commence a fine breeze from the Land W. Course
N. E. 8 by W. 2 W. all sail set Middle and latter part
much the same to Ends the day Lot 27, 15, 11 6. 51

Sunday August 15th

Begins a fresh breeze from S. W. Course S. W.
all sail set at 2 saw a sail on the weather
breeze steering northward Middle and latter
parts light winds and variable Lot 25, 55, 11 5. 15

Monday August 16th

Begins a light breeze and variable from S. W. 4
to S. E. Course S. W. all sail set Middle and
latter parts much the same to Ends the day Lot 24, 47
Long 4. 00
17th

Tuesday August 17th

Begins light winds varying from S. W. to S. E.
Course S. W. all sail set Middle and latter
much the same Employed in ships duty
Nothing in sight Lot 23, 57 Long 1. 00
