Thursday 24 August 1843

Begins a fine breeze and

Piques 2 sails in light at dusk shortened sail
middle and latter part some foggy employed in Bailing
and stowing down so ends steering S.W. under
short sail Factor in Company ^{Set by Obs}

Friday 25 August 1843

Begins light air from
N.N.W. and some foggy steering S.W. under
short sail employed in Bailing and stowing down
the Factor in light Company supplied
Capt. Howland with 4 Casks of Bread & 5 barrels
of Flour at 10 finished Bailing Latter part
fine weather made all sail and put away for
Hovee having 2500 blbls so ends employed
in stowing oil Factor in Company ^{Set by Obs}

Saturday August 26th 1843

Begins a fresh breeze from W.N.W. course
S.E. all sail set employed in stowing down oil Factor
in Company middle part fresh breeze latter part light
air from ~~from~~ and variable Course S.E. all
sail set Factor in Company ^{Set by Obs}
Sunday August 27th 1843

breeze from N and pleasant Course S by W all sail

Wednesday August 30th 1843

Begins a fresh breeze from N.W.
and passing clouds Course S by W all sail set
striding sail at 5 took it in again all sail
T G sail & all Royal middle part the same at
daylight set all Royal and lower striding sail
ends the same a fine breeze from N and pleasant
weather employed in fitting Riggery Bundling
Bone & cleaning the outside of the ship
Factor in Company
