Begins clear weather with a heavy smell
wind from E seeing E & E middle part much
the same at 6 AM saw a number of right whales
lowered the boats and struck at 12 took the whale
to the ship, thus ends the day No. 1015

December the 3rd

These 24 hours commences fine weather
employed in cutting the middle middle and latter
part employed boiling saw several whales lower
and chased so ends the day

December the 4th

Begins calm employed Chasing whales
and boiling middle and latter fine weather
employed in cutting a try put so ends the day

December the 5th

Begins fine weather employed in
chasing and Chasing whales at 7 spoke the
Bank Sea with 5 right whales and 450 blb
sperm oil thus ends the day

December the 6th

Begins fine weather at 5 lower and
got a whale and at daylight commences
cutting ends fine weather employed boiling
and Chasing whales thus ends the day

December the 7th

Begins fine weather employed boiling
and Chasing whales latter part the same one sail
in sight thus ends the day

December the 8th

Begins fine weather mine from the 1st
employed boiling and Chasing whales Ends
much the same Bangae Sea in sight Boiling

December the 9th

Begins weather employed in chasing
down and Chasing whales ends the same Bangae
Sea in sight

December the 10th

Begins fine weather employed storming
down and Chasing whales ends the same

December the 11th

Begins fine weather whales in sight
at 5 PM lower and struck two whales
and got two Boats stove at 10 AM
took the whales to the ship employed
cutting Nothing in sight so ends the day

December 12th

Begins Pleasant Employed in cutting at 4
finished cutting and commenced boiling middle and
latter part the same Nothing in sight thus ends

December 13th

Begins pleasant at 1 PM lower and struck a
whale took him to the ship and commenced
cutting at 7 finished cutting and went
