January the 6th

All these 24 hours fine pleasant
weather Steaming I & employed in boiling saw
nothing thus ends

January the 7th

All these 24 light winds and variable
steaming I & and I employed in boiling saw nothing

January the 8th

All these 24 hours fine weather steaming
to Eastward at same set finished boiling in the morning
Commenced showing down saw nothing so ends

January the 9th

Begins with a strong breeze from the W. D
steaming to the Eastward under short sail at 5
finished showing down saw plenty of night whales
luffed to the wind next morning saw plenty of whales
luffed down but did not strike boats blowing a gale

January the 10th

All these 24 hours strong gales and
rainy weather saw plenty of whales to regged to
lower thus ends the day

January the 11th

Begins more moderate at 1 P.M.
luffed and struck a whale took him to the
ship and cut him in and set the water

boats crews at 1 A.M. the water went on deck and the
Companies were gone some rascal or mother had thrown
them overboard Ends a gale from North

January the 12th

All these 24 hours a gale from North
Ship laying to latter part commenced boiling so ends

January the 13th

All these 24 hours more moderate with a
very heavy swell on ship standing on different tacks
under short sail latter part finished boiling saw nothing

January the 14th

All these 24 hours moderate gales from
North latter part employed showing down nothing
in sight thus ends the day

January the 15th

Begins a strong breeze from N.W. ship
under short sail all hands employed in showing
down and middle thick weather with some rain
Concludes clear into the steaming I & with all sail
set saw nothing Lat 36.24 Long 2.20 W

January the 16th

All these 24 hours light breeze and clear
weather steaming I & saw nothing Lat 36.47 Long 3.34

January the 17th

Begins fine weather seeing I & employed
in bundling down middle part a strong breeze
from North latter part the same saw nothing
thus ends the day Lat 37.28 Long 3.5 miles West
