

Saw a sail at 9 A.M. spoke with the Ship
Mirra Capt Parker of Sayhambour with
14,00 bls 1,600 Sperm, Bound home at
Midnight left the ship of her course ESE
thus ends the day Lat 36,50 Long 54,00 E

Saturday March the 1st 1840

Commences with a fine breeze
N.W. and overcast weather, Middle and latter
part clear weather and a light breeze at N.W.
steering ESE with all sail set, nothing in
sight, thus ends Lat 37,33 Long by Chron 56,46

Sunday March the 2^d

Commences with fine weather
and a light breeze at N.W. Middle and latter part
the same steering ESE with all sail set, employed
in ships duty thus ends Lat 37,30 Long 59,25 E

Tuesday March the 3^d

Commences with light breezes at N.W.
and fine weather latter part overcast weather
light airs and calm steering ESE saw nothing
thus ends the day Lat 37,20 Long 60,54 E

Wednesday March the 4th

Commences with light airs
and calm latter part overcast weather light
airs variable thus ends Lat 37,49 Long 63,36

Thursday March the 5th

Commences with overcast weather
and light airs at E Middle part calm and thick fog
light airs at N.W. Lat 38,10 Long 63,49 E

Friday March the 6th

Commences with light breezes
at N.W. latter part a strong breeze steering ESE
with all sail set employed this day repairing
the main topsail thus ends Lat 38,09 Long 66,50

Saturday March the 7th

Commences with a strong
breeze at N.W. Middle and latter part a strong
breeze at N.W. steering ESE with all sail
set employed in ships duty, saw nothing
thus ends the day Lat 38,05 Long 70,25 E

Sunday March the 8th

Commences with a strong
breeze at N.W. latter part the same, steering
ESE thus ends Lat 38,00 Long 74,26 E

Monday March the 9th

Commences with a strong
breeze at N.W. Middle part the same at 10 A.M.
Made Amsterdam Island bearing by compass
ESE Dist 40 Miles steering for the island with
all sail set at Midday the wind shifted to
ESE thus ends the day Lat 37,54

Tuesday March the 10th

Commences with a strong breeze
at ESE at 2 P.M. lowered two boats and sent
them in shore a fishing at 6 P.M. the boats
returned with 1,00 fine fish. Middle part thick
rainy weather latter fine weather at 8 A.M.
lowered 3 boats and sent them a fishing at 11 A.M.
the boats returned with 700 fine fish
thus ends the day Lat 37,54 Long
