

Monday March the 23rd

Commences with a strong breeze at S E and overcast weather. Heading N^o E by E at 7 P.M. took in sail and set bowsprit cross masts, Middle and latter part much the same ship under close reef topsails. Lat 3017 Long 106.40 E

Tuesday March the 24th

Commences with a strong breeze at S E and thick hazy weather heading N^o E under single reef topsails latter part the same employed in ships duty thus ends. Lat 2939 N^o Obs Long 107.00

Wednesday March the 25th

First part of these 24 hours Pleasant gales and cloudy weather heading N^o E latter part much the same employed in ships duty thus ends. Lat 2830 N^o Obs Long 107.50

Thursday March the 26th

Commences with pleasant gales S E and clear weather heading N^o E latter part much the same employed repairing the fore topsail thus ends. Lat 2746 Long by Chron 106.29

Friday March the 27th

Commences with fine weather and light winds at S E Middle part calm latter part light airs at S W steering N^o E with all sail set thus ends. Lat 2723 Long 107.14 E

Saturday March the 28th

First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather and light at S W ends the same employed in ships thus ends. Lat 2700 Long 107.

Sunday March the 29th

First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather and light airs at S W and steering N^o E with all sail set. Middle and latter part light airs and calm thus ends. Lat 2646 Long 107.25

Monday March the 30th

Commences with light airs and calm Middle and latter part a fine breeze at S E heading E N E with all sail set employed in Black Smithing and Stacking the Stacks and Anchor thus ends. Lat 2600 N^o Obs Long 107.00

Tuesday March the 31st

Commences with fine pleasant weather and a fine breeze at S E latter part the same employed in ships duty saw nothing thus ends. Lat 2530 Long By Chron 109.24 E

Wednesday April the 1st 1840

Commences with fine pleasant weather and light airs at S E; heading E N E latter part a fine breeze steering N^o E with all sail set thus ends. Lat 2502 Long 110.17

Thursday April the 2nd

Commences with fine weather and a moderate breeze at S E; saw one fine hawk latter part the same steering N^o E employed in ships duty thus ends. Lat 2411 Long 110.18

Friday April the 3rd

Commences with a fresh breeze at S E and overcast weather latter part the same thus ends. Lat 2324 Long 111.38 E
