

Saturday April the 4th

Commences with a fine breeze at S E, Steering N E with all sail set. Latter part the same, At 8 A M saw 3 sperm Whales going to the Thridward quick corner and Chased them but with success, thus ends Lat 24.00 Long 111.45

Sunday April the 5th

Commences with fine weather and light airs and calm Middle and latter part fine breeze saw nothing thus ends, Lat 23.27 Long 111.59 E

Monday April the 6th

Commences with fine weather and Pleasant breezes at S E; Steering N E Middle and latter much the same saw nothing thus ends Lat 22.38 Long 112.40 E

Tuesday April the 7th

Commences fine weather and a strong breeze at S E steering N E at sunset shortened sail at daylight main sail Latter part the same thus ends Lat 21.48 Long 113.08 E

Wednesday April the 8th

First part of these 24 hours strong winds, at sunset took in sail, wore ship and headed off shore; at daylight main sail headed in shore; at 9 A M saw the same the S W Cape of New Holland bearing per compass S E Dist 35 Miles saw several fine backs at midian left off N. employed in ships duty thus ends Lat 21.41 Long 113.40

Thursday April the 9th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather & pleasant breezes Steering N. at sunset shortened sail headed off shore at daylight main sail and steered N E saw nothing ends much the same Lat 21.12 Long By Obs 114.11 E

Friday April the 10th

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather & small breezes at S W at sunset shortened sail at daylight main all sail and steered N E saw nothing thus ends Lat 20.40 Long 114.40 E

Saturday April the 11th

All this day fine pleasant weather & a brisk breeze at S at sunset shortened sail at daylight main all sail & steered to the N E saw nothing thus ends, Lat 20.14 Long 115.18 E

Sunday April the 12th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather & a brisk breeze at S at 2 P M luffed to & sounded but found no bottom at sunset killed a dog, & shortened sail at daylight main sail & steered to the N E saw one fin back, Latter part much the same thus ends, Lat 19.32 Long 115.40 E

Monday April the 13th

Commences with fine weather & a brisk breeze at S at sunset shortened sail and luffed to, headed at the Thridward at daylight main all sail & steered to the N E saw nothing thus ends Lat 18.45 Long 116.06 E
