

Ship Montpelier July 1840
Monday July the 20th

Commences with strong trades and overcast weather. Steered N N W. Middle and latter part the same, employed in making casks thus ends the day. Lat 14.42 Long 104.07 E

Tuesday July the 21st

Commences with strong trades and overcast weather. Steered N N W. Middle and latter part the same, employed in making casks. thus ends the day. Lat 14.38 Long 102.33

Wednesday July the 22nd

Commences with strong trades and squally weather. Steered N N W. Middle and latter part the same, employed in making casks. so ends. Lat 13.34, At 8 P.M. the Long day Obs 100.31, At 9 P.M. the Long day Obs 99.46

Thursday July the 23rd

Commences with strong trades and squally weather. Steered N N W. at sunset shortened sail, At 7 P.M. luffed by the wind, headed N E, At 4 P.M. steered N W by W. Middle and latter part much the same; so ends Lat 12.33

Long day Obs 98.42

Friday July the 24th

Commences with strong trades and clear weather. Steered N N W. at sunset shortened sail, at 8 P.M. luffed by the wind headed to the S E at 4 P.M. steered West, so ends, Lat 12.06

Saturday July the 25th

Commences with strong trades and fine weather, At 2 P.M. saw the Coos Is. At 4 P.M. let go anchor in the harbor, ends with a strong breeze, employed in Ships duty so ends

Sunday the 26th

Commences with a strong breeze and squally weather, took a raft of casks a shore, Middle and latter part a thick rain storm, one Watch on shore; so ends

Monday July the 27th

Commences with a strong breeze at 8 P.M. and thick rainy weather; latter part fine weather employed in Wooding and Watering; thus ends

Tuesday July the 28th

Commences with fine weather, At 6 P.M. came a long side with a raft of Water; Middle and latter part the same, employed in Wooding and Watering

Wednesday July the 29th

All these 24 hours squally weather and a plenty of rain. Employed in Ship duty; so ends

Thursday July the 30th

Commences with squally weather and a plenty of rain, Middle and latter part fine weather, One watch on shore; Employed in Wooding and Ships duty; thus ends

Friday July the 31st All these 24 hours fine weather and Watch on shore Employed in Wooding and Ships duty thus ends the day
