

Ship Montpelier, Aug the 1st 1840
Saturday Aug the 1st

All these 24 hours fine weather, one
Watch on shore; Employed in Ship duty; thus ends

Sunday Aug the 2nd

All these 24 hours fine weather Employed
in Ship duty; one Watch on shore; so ends

Monday Aug the 3rd All these 24 hours fine weather
Employed in gathering Coconuts; thus ends

Tuesday Aug the 4th

All these 24 hours fine weather
Employed in gathering Coconuts; thus ends

Wednesday Aug the 5th

Commences with strong trade
and fine weather, At 6 A.M. got under way in Company
with the Huntress and stood out to sea. employed
stowing anchors unbending chains and stowing
them below decks, so ends, Lat 12, 23

Thursday Aug the 6th

Commences with strong trade
and fine weather, headed S by E; Middle and latter
part much the same, Employed in Ship duty
thus ends, Lat 13 58 Long 46, 36

Friday Aug the 7th

Commences with moderate trade
and fine weather, headed S by E; Middle and latter
part much the same; Employed painting the Hull and
Bark boats, thus ends Lat 15 11

Ship Montpelier 1840
Saturday Aug the 8th

Commences with light trade and fine weather
headed S by W; Middle and latter part strong trade and
squally, headed S W by S, so ends Lat 16, 34

Sunday Aug the 9th

Commences with strong trade and squally
weather, took to reefs in the topsails and headed S by E.

Middle and latter part the same thus ends, Lat 16 48

Monday Aug the 10th

Commences with very rough weather
Ship under 2 reef topsails and mainsail; the full headed
headed S W by S; Middle part more moderate set
the full and spraker and let one reef out of the Main
and Mizzen topsails, At 7 P.M. split the full, took it
in the spraker likewise, ends very rough with
a plenty of rain, Lat 16 48

Tuesday Aug the 11th

First part of these 24 hours very rough
squally weather, at sunset took in the mainsail
Middle part close reefed the fore and Mizzen
topsails, At 8 P.M. the Starboard Main topsail clew
parted, blew up the sail and repaired it, and
set the topsail close reefed, ends with a large sea
and squally weather, headed S by W, Lat 19, 51

Wednesday Aug the 12th

Commences with a gale, At P.M. took in
the foresail and Mizzen topsail, Middle part more moderate
set the courses and Mizzen topsail, ends very rough
with a plenty of rain, headed S by W, Lat 20 49
