

Ship Montpelier 1840
Tuesday Sept the 15th

Commences with a strong gale at S W, Middle part more moderate. Latter part a fresh breeze at S^W headed to the S E, saw two Whales but did not ascertain what they were, employed in ships duty, so ends, Lat 36, 19

Wednesday Sept the 16th

Commences with a moderate breeze at South, Middle and latter part much the same, #10 S W saw a Spinn Whale, down the boats and chased the Whale with out success, so ends, Lat 36 18, Long 109, 54 E

Thursday Sept the 17th

Commences with light airs and calm, Middle and latter part light breeze and squally weather, headed to the S E, employed in ships duty, so ends, Lat 36, 48, Long 110, 51 E

Friday Sept the 18th

Commences with fine weather and a moderate breeze at S W, headed S E, Middle part squally weather latter part a strong breeze at S E, headed to the S W, employed in ships duty, so ends, No Obs

Saturday Sept the 19th

Commences with a strong breeze at S E, Middle part the same, latter part a strong breeze at S^W at 8 AM, spoke the ship dock Winslow Remykepsse 18, 00, 00 3, 75 lb Spinn, steered S W by S, so ends, Lat 32, 12 Long 110, 30

Sunday Sept the 20th

All these 24 hours fine weather and a strong breeze at S W, steered S S W, saw several hump backs thus ends the day, Lat 33, 12

Ship Montpelier 1840
Monday Sept the 21st

Commences with strong breeze at S W and squally weather, steered S S W, at sunset took in sail, headed to the W, Middle part much the same, latter part a strong breeze at S W and thick overcast weather, employed in ships duty, so ends, Lat 34 14, Long 110, 03

Tuesday Sept the 22nd

Commences with a strong breeze at N S W, headed S, Middle and latter part much the same, nothing in sight, employed in ships duty, so ends, Lat 35, 16 Long 110 22 E

Wednesday Sept the 23rd

Commences with fine weather and a strong breeze at West, headed S S W, Middle part the same latter part a gale at S W, day by headed to the W, so ends Lat 36, 08

Thursday Sept the 24th

Commences with a gale at S W and squally weather, Middle part much the same, latter part light airs and calms, and a large swell, standing on different tacks, thus ends, Lat 35, 40, Long by Obs 109, 38,

Friday Sept the 25th

Commences with fine weather and a moderate breeze at West, headed S S W, one sail in sight, Middle part much the same, latter part light airs and calms and thick foggy weather, so ends, No Obs

Saturday Sept the 26th

Commences with light airs and calms and thick foggy weather, Middle and latter part a strong gale at S W and squally weather, at daylight took in foresail and ^{close} reefed the main topsail, headed N S W, so ends Lat 36, 10 Long 108, 57
