

Monday November the 2nd

Commences with fine weather and light airs employed in boiling and stowing down. Middle and latter part much the same, the chumming in sight boiling thus ends. Lat 37.21 Long 114.20 E



Tuesday November the 3rd

Commences with light airs and calm, at 4 P.M. saw 2 Whales, lower down struck one Whale at 10 past 11 P.M. took the Whale a long side, ends with light airs and calm employed in boiling. Lat 37.45

Wednesday November the 4th

Commences with light airs and calm employed in stowing down, Middle and latter part much the same, 2 ships in sight, employed in boiling, so ends. Lat 38.16

Thursday November the 5th

Commences with light airs and calm at 4 P.M. saw one right Whale lower down and started in the Whale, at sunset spoke with the Brighten with 7 Whales, Middle part the same, at daylight finished boiling latter part a moderate breeze at 5 P.M. started 2 P.M. 6 saw nothing, employed in stowing down, so ends. Lat 38.43

Friday November the 6th

Commences with fine weather, at sunset finished stowing down, Middle and latter part a strong breeze at South, Working to the S.E., saw nothing, employed repairing boat and raising shrouks thus ends. Lat 38.63

Saturday November the 7th

Commences with a strong breeze at S.E. saw right Whale, lower down chased with out success, Middle and latter part light airs, at 4 P.M. saw a Whale lower down struck, at midday took the Whale a long side, so ends. Lat 36.36



Sunday November the 8th

Commences with fine weather and light airs and at 11 employed cutting, at 5 finished, at 8 P.M. saw right Whales, lower down struck 2 Whales, ends with fine weather, the boats of part to the Whales, Lat 36.44

Monday November the 9th

Commences with fine weather at 4 P.M. took the last Whale a long side and commenced cutting, at 8 P.M. spoke the Maria 10 right Whales, 2nd 1000 bls. Sperm, latter part a strong breeze and squally weather employed cutting and boiling, 3 ships in sight, so ends. Lat 36.50



Tuesday November the 10th

Commences with a strong breeze at 11 P.M. spoke the Hercules Erickson New Bedford 1200 bls, 500 Sperm, latter part fine weather, employed in boiling, 5 ships in sight, so ends. Lat 36.46 Long 115.50 E

Wednesday November the 11th

Commences with fine weather Middle and latter part light airs and calm employed in boiling and stowing down, 2 ships in sight so ends. Lat 36.54



Thursday November the 12th

All these 24 hours light airs and calm, spoke with the latter Whidson 2700 bls, hauling one Whale at 11 P.M. saw one Whale, lower down got the Whale, so ends. Lat 37.07
