

Ship Montpelier on the Coast of New Holland
Friday November the 13th

All three 24 hours fine weather first part
employed cutting, latter part employed boiling and
stowing down, at sunset spoke with the Meno and Marther
saw no Whales this 24 hours, so ends. Lat 37°30'

Saturday November the 14th

All three 24 hours moderate breezes and
fine weather, at daylight finished sailing, 2 Ships in sight
saw no Whales, so ends. Lat 36°58'

Sunday November the 15th

Commenced with a moderate breeze
at 11, Middle and latter part a strong breeze at S.W. and
thick rainy weather, lay beached to the S. under short sail
all hands employed in their bunks, so ends. Lat 36°

Monday November the 16th

Commenced with a strong breeze at S.W.
and thick weather, Middle and latter part a gale and clear
weather, employed cleaning down, lay by beached to the S.
Lat 36°37'

Tuesday November the 17th

Commenced with a gale at S.W.
and clear weather, latter part fine weather, employed
stowing down, saw nothing, so ends. Lat 36°58'

Wednesday November the 18th

Commenced with light airs at W.
and fine weather, Middle and latter part same, employed
raising shocks, saw nothing, so ends. Lat 37°16'

Thursday November the 19th

Commenced with light airs and
calms, Middle part the same, latter part a strong breeze at
N.W., working to the S.E., saw nothing, employed raising
shocks and bundling down, so ends. Lat 37°26', Long 116°58'

Friday November the 20th

Commenced with a strong breeze at S.W.
Middle and latter part much the same, steered to the S.E.
saw nothing, employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 37°46'
Long 118°37'

Saturday November the 21st

Commenced with a strong breeze
at W., Middle and latter part a moderate breeze and
squally weather, beached to the S. saw nothing, so ends.
Lat 38°16'

Sunday November the 22nd

Commenced with a moderate breeze
at W., and squally weather, Middle and latter part light
airs and calms, all sail set, working to the W., saw a
school of Black fish, thus ends. Lat 38°43' Long 117°06' E.

Monday November the 23rd

Commenced with light airs and calms
Middle and latter part a fine breeze at E.N.E., steered
W., at daylight saw a Ship standing to the Eastward, saw
several fin backs, so ends. Lat 38°46' Long 117°27' E.

Tuesday November the 24th

Commenced with strong breezes
at S.W., Middle and latter part much the same, steered
W.N.W., saw several fin backs, so ends. Lat 38°01'
Long 117°38'
