Thursday January the 7th

All these 24 hours fine weather, At 10 A.M. got under way in Company with the Caroline and stood out to sea; left in the bay the Unicorn, 700 Spenn 300 W. the Hebeonia 400 Spenn the Jette 350 Spenn, and the Gallant 7 mortars out no Crib, employed stowing anchors and extending chains and stowing them below, so ends.

Friday January the 8th

Commenced with a strong breeze at 8 am fine weather, steered N.W. Middle am better part much the same, At 5 P.M. spoke with the Apolonia, employed in Ship's duty, so ends. Lat 33.40 Long 113.09 E.

Saturday January the 9th

All this 24 hours strong winds from S and S.E. standing on different tacks, one sail in sight. employed in Ship's duty, so ends. Lat 33.19 Long 113.11 E.

Sunday January the 10th

Commenced with a fresh breeze at 8 am at S.E. Middle am better part much the same, headed to the S.W. at 11 A.M. spoke with the Hopeless, so ends. Lat 33.21

Long 112.04 E.

Monday January the 11th

Commenced with a fresh breeze at 8 am pleasant weather, Middle am better part much the same employed repairing sails so ends, Lat 33.23

Tuesday January the 12th

All these 24 hours fresh breezes and pleasant weather, At 2 P.M. spoke with two Ships, the Ann Bayly Harbour 2200 bbls 400 Spenn, the Berkley New Bedford 300 bbls 100 W. Lat 33.04 Long 111.10 E.
