

Ship Montpelier on the West Coast of New Holland 1841

Wednesday January the 13th

Commences with a fresh breeze at S & and fine weather, at 1 P.M. spoke the Sun and put our letters on board Middle and Latter part much the same. Working to the N.W. employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat ^{33.00} 33.00 Long 108.00 E

Thursday January the 14th

Commences with a fresh breeze at S & and pleasant weather. Middle and Latter part much the same at 10 A.M. spoke with Ship Sun; Working to the N. employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat ~~33.00~~ 32.01

Friday January the 15th

Commences with a fresh breeze at S & and over-cast weather; Middle and Latter part much the same, at 7 A.M. saw two sperm Whales going quick, did not lower, one Ship in sight, so ends. Lat 32.48 Long 109.47 E

Saturday January the 16th

Commences with a fresh breeze at S, at 2 P.M. spoke with the Banoley; Middle part the same, Latter part light airs and fine weather, heading on different tracks employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 31.30 Long 109.39 E

Sunday January the 17th

Commences with a strong breeze at S & and fine weather; Middle and Latter part a strong breeze at W and squally weather, standing on different tracks, saw nothing, so ends. Lat 31.31 Long 109.41 E

Monday January the 18th

Commences with a strong breeze at W, Middle and Latter part much the same, standing on different tracks, employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 31.30

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Tuesday January the 19th

Commences with a strong breeze at S & and thick overcast weather, Steered N, at sunset lulled by the wind, lulled to the W. Middle and Latter part much the same employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 30.32 Long 108.55 E

Wednesday January the 20th

Commences with a fresh breeze at S and overcast weather, one Ship in sight, Middle and Latter part much the same, standing on different tracks, employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 29.37

Thursday January the 21st

Commences with a fresh breeze at S & and overcast weather, at 2 P.M. spoke with the Scholes Brigges New Bedford 6 months out, 60 bbls; Middle and Latter part much the same, employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 30.10 Long 108.10 E

Friday January the 22nd

Commences with a fresh breeze at S & and overcast weather; Middle part the same, Latter part a moderate breeze and fine weather, working to the N. saw nothing employed in Ship duty, so ends. Lat 29.14 Long 108.14 E

Saturday January the 23rd

Commences with a fresh breeze at S and fine weather, at 5 P.M. saw several Boonches but could not tell what they were; Middle and Latter part much the same, employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 28.31 Long 107.30 E

Sunday January the 24th

All these 24 hours strong wind and breezy weather, standing to the N.E., saw nothing, so ends. Lat 27.58 Long 108.10 E
