

Ship Montpelier in the Atlantic Ocean 1841

Thursday Sept the 16th

Commences with light winds at W & W
steers to the N.W. Middle and latter part light baffling
winds and rainey, so ends. No Obs. Lat by a count 11.00 N

Friday Sept the 17th

Commences with light baffling winds
with rain, Middle and latter part a brisk breeze at
W by S and fine weather steered N.W. by S, so ends
Lat 12.17 Long 34.29

Saturday Sept the 18th

Commences with a fine breeze
at S.W. steering N.W. Middle part the same latter
part light winds and calms, employed in Ships duty
thus ends. Lat 13.13 N. Long by a count 35.30 W

Sunday Sept the 19th

Commences with light winds at N.N.E
Middle and latter part a moderate breeze and over-
cast weather steered N.W. 1/2 W, so ends Lat 13.34 Long 37.27

Monday Sept the 20th

Commences with light winds and over-
cast weather at 4 P.M. past a Brig standing to the S.E.
Middle and latter part a brisk trade, employed in Ships
duty, so ends. Lat 14.37 Long 39.0 W

Tuesday Sept the 21st

All these 24 hours fresh winds and over-
cast weather steered N.W. 1/2 W, employed in Ships duty
so ends. Lat 15.56 Long by Chron 41.58 W

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Wednesday Sept the 22nd

All these 24 hours fresh winds and
over cast weather steered N.W. employed in painting Boats
thus ends. Lat 17.30 Long by Chron 44.28 W

Thursday Sept the 23rd

All these 24 hours moderate winds and
fine weather, at 6 A.M. saw a Brig standing to the W.N.
steered N.W. employed in Ships duty, so ends
Lat 18.44 N. Long by Chron 46.18 W

Friday Sept the 24th

All these 24 hours moderate winds and
fine weather steered N.W. employed in painting Ship
so ends. Lat 19.57 N. Long by Chron 48.14 W

Saturday Sept the 25th

All these 24 hours moderate winds and
fine weather, steered N.W. employed in painting Ship
so ends. Lat 21.03 N. Long by a count 50.08 W

Sunday Sept the 26th

All these 24 hours moderate winds and
fine weather steered N.W. so ends. Lat 22.06 Long 51.39

Monday Sept the 27th

All these 24 hours strong winds and especially
with rain steered N.W. employed in Ships duty, so ends
Lat 23.31 N. Long 53.52 W

Tuesday Sept the 28th

All these 24 hours fresh winds and fine
weather steered N.W. saw one Sail standing to the S.W.
employed in Ships duty, so ends. Lat 24.58 Long 55.51 W
