Commences with light winds at E. and squally steering S. Middle and Latter part light airs and calms with a plenty of rain working to the S. employed in Ships duty thus ends.

Wednesday March the 1st

Commences with light winds at E. At 3 P.M. saw a school of Black Fish. Lower the Boat's best could not strike. Middle and Latter part much the same working to the S. employed in Ship duty

Thursday March the 2nd

Commences with light airs at S.E. and fine pleasant weather Middle and Latter part light variable winds and squally headed to the S. employed in Ships duty, thus ends.

Friday March the 3rd

Commences with a fine breeze at E.S.E. and clear weather Middle and Latter part fresh trade and fine pleasant weather headed to the S. one sail in sight standing to the N. employed in Ships duty thus ends.
