

Ship Montpelier on the Coast of Brazil 1842

Sunday April the 3rd

Commences with brisk breezes and fine pleasant weather steered S.W. Middle and Latter part strong winds at N.E. and fine clear weather standing on different tacks saw nothing thus ends
Lat by Obs 30.40 Long by Chron 47.00 W

Monday April the 4th

All three parts strong winds at N.E. and fine weather First part steered W.S.W. and sail in sight standing to the N.W. Middle and Latter part standing on different tacks at day light saw one sail steering to the South, employed in Ships duty, thus ends
Lat by Obs 31.12 Long by Chron 46.10 W

Tuesday April the 5th

First and Middle parts strong winds at N.E. and fine weather steered East carrying all forward sail saw nothing; Latter part more moderate all sail at steering East employed in Ships duty
Lat by Obs 31.26 No Obs

Wednesday April the 6th

Commences with light winds at N.E. and fine weather Middle and Latter part much the same; headed E. carrying all sails saw nothing, employed in Ships duty
Lat by Obs 31.34 Long by Chron 42.44 W

Thursday April the 7th

Commences with light winds at N.E. and fine pleasant weather Middle and Latter part much the same, steering East saw several firm Back, employed in Ships duty the ends
Lat by Obs 31.49 Long by Chron 43.9 W

Friday April the 8th

Commences with a fine breeze at N.E. and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part much the same, steered E. saw one sail standing to the N.E., employed in Ships duty.
Lat by Obs 32.00 Long by Chron 47.27 W

Ship Montpelier in the South Atlantic Ocean 1842

Saturday April the 9th

Commences with brisk breezes at N. and fine weather Middle part a brisk breeze at W. Latter part strong winds at South and thick rainy weather steering E. carrying all forward sail saw two sail steering to the N. Employed in Ships duty, thus ends
Lat by Obs 32.02 Long by Chron 44.45 W

Sunday April the 10th

Commences with strong breezes at South and over cast weather Middle and Latter part moderate the wind S.E. headed E.N.E. saw nothing thus ends
Lat by Obs 31.09 Long by Chron 32.19 W

Monday April the 11th

Commences with light winds at S.E. and fine pleasant weather, heading E.N.E. at 4 P.M. saw Green Whales, it being near night and the Whales going to windward did not lower; Middle and Latter part much the same, employed repairing a Fore Top sail. It rained and bent the Fore Top sail, and bent a mother, thus ends
Lat by Obs 30.32 Long by Chron 31.58 W

Tuesday April the 12th

Commences with light airs and calms and fine pleasant weather Middle and Latter part a fine breeze at N.W. steered E. by S. saw one firm Back employed repairing a Fore Top sail, thus ends
Lat by Obs 30.40 Long by Chron 30.22 W

Wednesday April the 13th

Commences with fine breezes at N.W. and pleasant weather Middle and Latter part light variable winds, steered E. by S. saw one firm Back employed repairing a Fore Top sail, & painting a Boat, thus ends
Lat by Obs 30.27 Long by Chron 29.11 W

Thursday April the 14th

Commences with light airs and calms, headed to the S. At sunset part a ship steering N. Middle and Latter part fine breezes at N. and clear weather, steered E. by S. carrying all sail, employed in Ships duty, thus ends
Lat by Obs 30.48 Long by Chron 47.19 W
