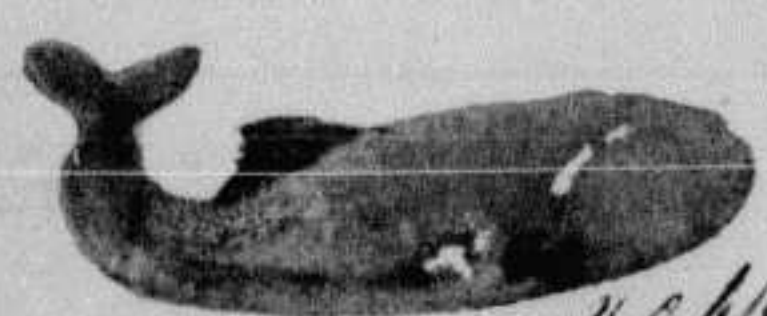


Ship Montpelier of Madagascar Cruising 1842

Wednesday Sept 14th

Commences with light airs and calms, Middle part much the same, latter part a brisk breeze at 11. and equally, steered E N E. saw nothing, employe in Ships duty, thus ends

Lat by Obs 2637. S Long by Chron 24.14.9 E



40.66 Thursday Sept 15th

First and Middle parts strong breeze at West, steered E N E. latter part light winds and fine pleasant weather, all day light sun. Humpbacks, down the Boat and struck two Whales, got one, and lost the other, saw a Ship steering to the Eastward, thus ends the Boat off Port to the Whales

Lat by a count 26.00. S. Long by a count 24.20. E.

Friday Sept 16th

All there 24 hours brisk breezes and fine weather, employe in cutting in the Whale, at 9.1 M finished cutting, and commenced Boiling, saw many Humpbacks but the Sun being rather near did not burn, and fine weather the Ship heading off shore, employe Boiling

Long by Obs 25.37. S. Long by Chron 24.5.46 E

Saturday Sept 17th

Commences with a brisk breeze at S E. Ship heading to the S. saw Whales down and chased with out success. Middle part much the same, latter part a strong gale at S E. Long by heading to the S. employe in Boiling, at Noon finished Boiling thus ends

Lat by Obs 26.19. S. Long by a count 24.50. E

Sunday Sept 18th

Commences with a gale at S E. and over cast weather, Middle and latter part much the same standing on different tacks, under short sail saw nothing, thus ends

Lat by Obs 26.44. S. Long by Chron 24.57. E

Monday Sept 19th

Commences with a gale at S E. and over cast weather, Middle part more moderate made all pendant sail heading South; latter part light airs and fine pleasant weather, saw Humpbacks, employe repairing the Main Top sail, thus ends

Lat by Obs 27.09. S. Long by Chron 24.09. E

Tuesday Sept 20th

First and Middle part brisk breezes at E. and fine weather heading S S E. at 8 P M tacked Ship headed S S E. latter part light airs and calms, saw nothing, employe repairing the Main Top sail, thus ends

Lat by Obs 27.03. South. Long by Chron 24.40. E

Wednesday Sept 21st

Commences with light airs and calms, Middle part a brisk breeze at E headed N N E. latter part light airs and calms, saw several Humpbacks, employe repairing the Jib, thus ends

Lat by Obs 26.35. S. Long by Chron 24.18. E

Thursday Sept 22nd

First and Middle part light airs and baffling, employe repairing the Jib, latter part a fine breeze at S E. steered S E. saw nothing, employe in Ships duty, thus ends

Lat by Obs 25.43. S. Long by Chron 24.16. E

Friday Sept 23rd

All there 24 hours light variable winds, and fine pleasant weather, Ship working to the Eastward, saw Humpbacks, employe in Ships duty, thus ends

Lat by Obs 25.55. S. Long by Chron 24.52. E

Saturday Sept 24th

Commences with light airs and calms, saw Humpbacks, down the Boat and chased with out success, Middle part strong breeze at S E. headed South. latter part a gale, at E. long by under short sail heading S E. employe in Ships duty thus ends

Lat by Obs 27.07. Long by Chron 24.35. E
