Thursday November 17th



Commenced with fine weather plenty of Whales in sight
lower and struck one Whale and killed it about 3 hours the
Whale swimming and rounding Carrier away the back of
the Boat and then cut the line lost the Whale's insides and one
Lower latter part fresh breezes at N. W. saw Whales did not lower
employed in stowing down & Bailing this

Friday November 18th

Commenced with fresh breezes and rough saw several Whales did not
lower employed stowing down & Bailing. Middle and latter
part a moderate gale at N. and thick weather saw Whales
to rough to lower, employed Bailing this ends

Bailing. Middle part more moderate with rain latter part

Sunday November 20th



Commenced with moderate winds at S by E and overcast saw
several Whales lower and struck one Whale and down, Middle
and latter part fine pleasant weather; at 4. M. saw two Whales going
quick to the S. E. lower the Boats and chased with out success ends with
Whales in sight and the Boats in chase

Monday November 21st



Commenced with fine weather and moderate winds at N. E. at 10. M.
struck a Whale and killed it at 2 P. M. took the Whale a long side at 3
Commenced cutting at 5 finished cleaned the decks and commenced
Bailing at daylight saw several Whales lower and struck 3 Whales
and down from all 3 struck one of the same Whales and killed it at 12. part
10 took the Whale a long side and commenced cutting, ends with fine
weather and Whales in sight.

Tuesday November 22nd

Commenced with light winds at N. E. and overcast with some
fog at 12. part 3 finished cutting and started the Whales, Middle and
latter part a moderate gale at N. with squalls of rain
Ship standing and different tacks saw nothing of any account
employed Bailing and stowing down this ends
