Commences with a moderate gale at E. with squalls of rain. Middle part much the same. Latter part light winds and fine weather. saw one Whale, Lancer and Boat Dante and Miss the Whales Dante twice more at the same. Whales employed Boiling and stowing down, thus ends.

Thursday November 24th

Commences with fine weather saw Whales Lancer and Dante and Miss with out success, employed Boiling and stowing down. Middle and Latter part stormy breezes at S.W. at 9 A.M. saw one Whale, Lancer and Chase with out success, employed Boiling and stowing down, thus ends.

Wednesday November 25th

Commences with strong breezes at E. with a heavy smell at 1 P.M. finished Boiling, saw one Whale Lancer and Dante and Miss, employed stowing down, Middle and Latter parts fine pleasant weather, saw nothing but finbacks employed in cleaning Bower and repairing the Lancer and Boat, thus ends.

Saturday November 26th

Commences with light winds at E. and fine weather, at Steering. We by E. at 1 P.M. saw Whales Lancer and Chase with out success, Middle part much the same, Latter part strong breezes at E. and thick hazy weather at 4 A.M. saw Whales Lancer and struck one Whale and killed it. At Noon the took the Whale a long side, thus ends.

Sunday November 27th

Commences with strong winds at E. and thick rainy weather at E. Commenced cutting, at 5 finished, Middle part thick rainy weather, Latter part a gale at E. and over cast at daylight. Commenced Boiling, saw nothing thus ends.

Monday November 28th

Commences with a gale at E. and over cast, Middle part much the same. Latter part more moderate with thick misty weather from 10 till Noon clear weather, saw Whales did not Lancer employed in Boiling, thus ends.

Lat by Obs 35, 28, S. Long by Obs 69, 20 E

Tuesday November 29th

Commences with a strong breeze at E. and clear at 2 P.M. thick and rainy. Bore down the Wanks, Middle part much the same at 4 A.M. started the Wanks, Latter part more moderate with squalls of rain, saw Whales did not Lancer, employed Boiling and stowing down, thus ends.

Lat by Obs 35, 28, S. Long by Obs 69, 24 E

Wednesday December 30th

Commences with a fresh breeze with squalls of rain, saw Whales Lancer and Boat and Chase with out success, Middle part much the same, at 3 P.M. finished Boiling, Latter part fine pleasant weather, saw nothing but finbacks, employed stowing down, thus ends.

Thursday December 31st

Commences with fine weather employed stowing down saw one Whale, Lancer and Boat struck the Whale and the men drew and lost the Whale at sunset finished stowing down, saw one Ship, Middle and Latter part light winds and fine weather at daylight. Made all sail at 7, saw 2 Whales Lancer and Boat and struck one Whale and killed it. At 10 part 4, took the Whale a long side and commenced cutting, at noon finished, and sail in sight cutting, so ends.
