Sunday April 9th 1843.

All there 24 hours light baffling winds and squally with showers of rain. Ship working to the North East, saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty and repairing the West Boat, thus ends.

Monday April 10th

All there 24 hours a brisk breeze, raining from E to N E, heading to the S E. at 12 past 2. saw, tacked Ship, headed N by E. at 4. N. E. tacked, headed S. E. we had fine pleasant weather, but a head wind, all sail set, saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty, thus ends.

Tuesday April 11th

Commences with a brisk breeze at E N E and fine weather, Ship heading N. Middle part light winds at E by N heading N by E. at daylight saw one of the Society Islands bearing per Compass West Dist 6. Miles. Latter part a moderate breeze at E by S heading N E by N. all sail set, saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty and repairing the West Boat that was stove by a sperm whale, Robinson 4th up Vandemans Lamm, thus ends.

Wednesday April 12th

All there 24 hours brisk breeze and raining from E N E to E by S. Ship heading N to N E by N. all sail set, saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty and repairing the West Boat, thus ends.

Thursday April 13th

Commences with a brisk breeze at East and fine pleasant weather. Middle part a strong breeze at E by S and squally. Ship heading N E by N. all forward sail set. Latter part light winds at E by N heading N by E. all sail set saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty and repairing the West Boat, thus ends.

Sunday April 16th

All there 24 hours light winds and raining from N E to East, at 1 P.M. tacked Ship, headed E S E, at Midnight tacked Ship, headed N by E. 1/2 E. all sail set, saw nothing, thus ends.

Monday April 17th

Commences with light winds at E by S. Ship heading N by E. Middle and Latter part a moderate breeze at E S E ship heading N E by N. all sail set, saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty and repairing the Fine Ships with, thus ends.

Tuesday April 18th

All there 24 hours light winds and raining from E by S to N E. Ship heading from N E by N to N N W. at 12 past 11. N. E. tacked Ship, headed E S E. All sail set, saw nothing. Employed in Ships duty and repairing the Fine Ships with, thus ends.
