Commences with fine weather, saw Whales 1 or 2

1.2 Months out 2.4.00 Bbls. Lutter part fresh breeze and

lower and pursued, got one Boat stove kill the Whale
at 10 part 10 took the Whale a long ride and commenced
cutting, thus ends. Lat 53.35. N Long 150.37. W

Saturday June 24th

Commences with fine weather, Employed cutting
at sunset got the Head in, Day by the Booby, threw the
weight, Lutter part a fresh breeze and ruggo, finished
cutting the Whale and commenced Boobies, 2 Ships in
sight, thus ends

Sunday June 25th

All these 24 hours fresh breeze and variable at 7 A.M. spoke
Ship of one Reas Edger Towns 1.2 Months out 3.4.00 Bbls
8.00 Sperm Employed in Boobies, thus ends

Monday June 26th

All these 24 hours fresh breeze and ruggo with squally
weather, Steering N.W. ~~with~~ saw Nothing. Employed
in Boobies, thus ends.

Tuesday June 27th

Commences with strong winds and ruggo Day by
steering W by N, the wind at N. one Ship in sight
Middle part much the same, Lutter part light winds
and moderate, saw Nothing but one Ship Employed in
stowing down and Boobies, thus ends

Wednesday June 28th

Commences with light winds and fine weather, Ship
heading N.E. at 8 P.M. finished Boobies, Middle part
much the same, Lutter part a strong breeze, at 9.45
and over cast, steered N.W. saw Whales did not chase
two Ships in sight. Employed in stowing down
thus ends. No Ob.

Thursday June 29th

Commences with a fresh breeze at 8.45 and over
cast, Employed in stowing down At 2 P.M. spoke
Ship Luzon Statt New Bedford 2.1.2 Months out 2.1.00 Bbls
Middle and Lutter part much the same, saw Nothing
Employed in repairing the Boat, thus ends
