Commences with a fresh breeze at N. N. W. and fine pleasant weather steering S. N. E. Nothing in sight. At 4 P. M. lapped by the wind headed S by W. at 6 P. M. saw several Humpbacks & one or 2 Whales yawning quick to North Middle and Latter part strong winds at W. and over cast. Ship heading S. W. all prudent sail set. one Ship in sight. at 10 A. M. saw one or 2 Whales bowen without success. Thus ends.

No. All these 24 hours fresh breezes and variable, at 2 P. M. spoke Ship Indian Chief Skinner New London 89. Months out 1200 bbls. at 5 A. M. saw one Whale Lamer's struck and down from the Whales. ends steering S. N. E. Nothing in sight but one Ship. No Ob. Long by Chron 150.23 West

Tuesday July 4th

Commences with moderate winds at W. and over cast steering S. N. E. Middle and Latter part the same with thick rainy weather. saw Nothing. Thus ends.

Wednesday July 5th

Commences with light winds at S. E. and thick rainy weather steering per Compass S. N. E. At 4 P. M. the fog lifted. saw one or 2 Whales Lamer's and Jarem's got the Boat stove Bad and one Man hurt. not Dangerously lost the Whale. Middle part bay by in short sail. Latter part strong winds at S. E. and ruggs. saw several Whales yawning quick to Windward. 3 Ships in sight. Thus ends.

Lat by Ob. 55.14. N. Long by Chron 149.52. West

Thursday July 6th

Commences with strong winds at S. W. and over cast. Middle and Latter part moderate at 7 A. M. saw Whales Lamer's Danted and Mire's. Chase the Whales with out success. Came on Board. saw more Whales. Lamer's with out success. one Ship in sight. Thus ends.

Lat by Ob. 54.12. N. a No Ob.

Friday July 7th

Commences with light airs and calms. 3 Ship in sight. Middle and Latter part much the same. saw Whales yawning quick. Lamer's with out success. Employed in steering down thus ends.



2.20 Saturday July 8th

Commences with light airs and calms. at 2 P. M. saw one Whale Lamer's and Jarem's. At 10. Mid night took the Whale. a long sail on. at 4 P. M. Compass was cutting. 3 Ships in sight. ends with light airs and fine pleasant weather.

Sunday July 9th

All these 24 hours light winds and fine weather at sunset finished cutting. at 3 A. M. Commenced Reeling 1 Ship in sight. saw No Whales. Thus ends.
