

Ship Montpelier Cruising For Whales, 1843

Saturday July 22nd

All there 24 hours light airs and calms, saw plenty of Finbacks, and one Ship. steering to the S.W. Employed repairing a Boat. Thus ends

Lat by Ob 55.13 N

Sunday July 23rd

Commences with light airs and fine weather. Middle and latter part strong winds and squally with rain, the wind veering from W to S.W. Ship heading to the South, all prudent sail set, and Ship in sight and a plenty of Finbacks, thus ends

Lat by Ob 54.04 N

Monday July 24th

Commences with strong wind at S.W. and rugged squally weather. Middle part the same. Ship heading S.E. all prudent sail set. Latter part strong winds at S. and thick rainy weather heading S.E. and Ship in sight. Thus ends No Ob.

Tuesday July 25th

All there 24 hours thick rainy weather. First and Middle part strong winds and rugged. Latter part more moderate. Ship heading S.E. to S.W. all prudent sail set, saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Thus ends No Ob.

Wednesday July 26th

All there 24 hours brisk winds at S.W. and thick foggy weather with rain. Heading S.E. all prudent sail set, saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Thus ends No Ob.

Thursday July 27th

All there 24 hours brisk winds from S.W. to W. and thick fog, steamed per Compass S.E. all sail set, saw Nothing. Employed Scraping Boats. Thus ends No Ob.

Friday July 28th

All there 24 hours fresh breeze from W to N.W. and thick over cast weather. Steamed per Compass S.E. all sail set, saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Thus ends. Lat 47.12 N. Long 127.24 W. Lat

Saturday July 29th

All there 24 hours moderate breezes at S.W. and over cast, steamed per Compass S by E. all sail set, saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Thus ends.

No Ob.

Sunday July 30th

All there 24 hours brisk breezes and veering from West to N. and thick foggy weather, with rain. Steamed per Compass South. all sail set, saw Nothing. Thus ends.

Monday July 31st

All there 24 hours strong breezes from W.N.W. and West with thick squally weather and rain. Steamed per Compass South. saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Thus ends. Long by Ob 128.12 West

Lat by Ob 48.33 N.

Tuesday August 1st 1843

All there 24 hours moderate winds and veering from West to S.W. Ship heading to the South, all sail set, saw Nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. Thus ends

Lat by Ob 3403

Wednesday August 2nd

All there 24 hours light winds and veering from S.W. to South, and fine pleasant weather. Ship heading to the S.E. all sail set, saw Nothing. Employed Draying Beams. Thus ends. Lat by Ob 3532 N. Long by Chron 128.13 West
