Sunday August 27th

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather; at 2 P.M. sailed
Ship Cambria on a Cruise, arrived Ship Pacific Coast
New Bedford 16.00 blbs, 2.50. Spent this day 3 Men
Deported from the Ship

Monday August 28th

All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather all Hands on
Board Doing Nothing, arrived Ship Huntress. Taker
of New Bedford 32.00 blbs 5.00 blbs Spent Room
Ship Guardian Hauland Box of New Bedford 16 Months
out 24.00 blbs. Sailing of and on, Bound to Whales, arrived
Ship William Thompson Elder of New Bedford 12 Months
out 9.00 blbs re Whale, thus ends

Tuesday August 29th

Commenced with fine weather, arrived Ship Nile Cook
of New Bedford 27 Months out 13.00 blbs Spent 5.00 re
Whale at 7 A.M. got under way with a fine breeze at
N.E. and stood out to sea, all hands Employed stowing
anchors and bending chains and stowing them below
their ends

Wednesday August 30th

Commenced with a brisk breeze at N.E. and fine weather
steering per Compass & the Sun in sight, all hands
Employed fitting of Boats and Ship's duty, Middle
and Latter part light airs and Calms, saw Nothing
thus ends. Put by 14.16 A. Spent by 13.00

Thursday August 31st

All these 24 hours brisk winds at E.S.E. and
squally with over cast weather, steered per
Compass South, all forward sail set, saw Nothing
Employed Pointing of Boats and Ship's duty, thus ends
Put by 16.23 A. Spent by 15.57 West

Ship Montpelier Making a Passage to New Zealand

1823

Friday September 1st

Commenced with brisk N.E. trade winds and over cast
weather, Middle and Latter much the same steered
per Compass South all sail set, saw Nothing Employed
in Ship's duty thus ends. Put by 14.22 A. Spent by 15.25

Saturday September 2nd

All these 24 hours brisk N.E. trade winds and fine
weather, steered per Compass South all sail set
saw Nothing Employed in Ship's duty thus ends
Put by 12.13 A. Spent by 15.04 West

Saturday September 3rd

All these 24 hours brisk trade winds and fine pleasant
weather, steered per Compass S by E. all sail set
saw Nothing, thus ends. Put by 10.00 A. Spent by
15.38

Monday September 4th

All these 24 hours brisk N.E. trade winds and fine weather
steered per Compass S by E. all sail set, saw
Nothing Employed in Ship's duty, thus ends
Put by 7.30 A. Spent by 15.24 West

Tuesday September 5th

Commenced with a fresh breeze at E.N.E. and
squally, Middle part light hawking winds with
rain, Latter part a strong breeze at E. and squally
headed S by E all forward sail set, saw Nothing
Employed in Ship's duty thus ends

Put by 6.04 A. Spent by 13.00

Wednesday September 6th

All these 24 hours brisk winds and raining from
E to S.E. with fine pleasant weather heading
per Compass S by W to S by E all sail set saw
Nothing but Benet, Employed in Ship's duty, thus ends
Put by 4.16 A
