Tuesday March 5th

Commences with light breezes at S.W. and overcast. Ship steering per Compass N.N.W. all drawing sail set. Middle part light winds and veering from N.W. to S.W. and thick rainy weather. Ship heading from N.E. to N.W. all sail set. Latter part a fine breeze at S. steered per Compass N.N.W. saw nothing this ends

Wednesday March 6th

Commences with moderate breezes at S.E. and overcast. steering N.W. all sail set. Lower and Topmast standing sails, saw 4. Brownie Backs. Middle and Latter part light airs and Calms and overcast. Ship making to the W. saw nothing. Employed in Ship's duty, saw ends

Lat by Obs 53.41 South. Long by Chron 61.46 West

Thursday March 7th

Commences with light airs at West. Inclining to Calms. Ship heading N.N.W. Middle part Calms. Latter part a light breeze at N. and overcast. Ship heading W.N.W. all sail set. saw nothing. Employed repairing a Main Top-sail. this ends

Friday March 8th

Commences with light breezes at N.N.E. and thick weather. Steered N.W. all sail set. Middle part much the same. Latter part a moderate breeze and veering from S.E. to W. and overcast. Steered per Compass N.N.W. all sail set. saw nothing. Employed in Ship's duty, this ends

Saturday March 9th

Commences with moderate breezes at W.N.W. and fine weather. Ship heading N. all sail set. Middle part light winds Inclining to Calms. Latter part a moderate breeze at S.E. and fine pleasant weather. Steered per Compass N. all drawing sail set. Lower and Topmast standing sails. Employed in repairing a Main Top-sail. saw nothing this ends. Lat by Obs 50.00 S. Long by Chron 63.00 West

Sunday March 10th

Commences with a brisk breeze at S.E. and fine pleasant weather. steering per Compass N. Middle part winds veering from S.E. to East. Latter part moderate winds from S to N.E. Ship heading N to N.N.W. all sail set. saw nothing. this ends

Lat by Obs 48.37 S. Long by Chron 62.14 West

Monday March 11th

Commences with a brisk breeze at N.E. and overcast. Ship heading N.N.W. all sail set. at 1 P.M. found N.E. bottom at 4 Fathoms. Middle part strong winds at N.E. by S. and squally Inclining to rain. took in sail as cases required. Latter part fresh gales and thick rainy weather. Ship heading N.N.W. under short. At 11.30. Hove Ship to S.E. saw nothing this ends

Tuesday March 12th

Commences with fresh breezes at N.E. and thick fog. Ship heading S.E. & at 8 P.M. found bottom at 60 Fathoms at 3 the wind hauled to the West. and cleared off. Made all proudant sail steered per Compass N.N.E. Middle and Latter part light freshening winds Inclining to Calms. Ship making to the N.E. saw nothing. Employed mainly by Brought one Rencetter this ends

Wednesday March 13th

All there 24 hours light hupling winds and showers of rain. with thick fog. Ship making to the N.E. saw nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. this ends

Commences with a fine breeze at West and pleasant weather. steering per Compass N.E. by N. Middle part much the same. Latter part a brisk breeze at S.W. and squally. steered per Compass N.E. & all drawing sail set. saw nothing. Employed in Ship's duty. this ends
