Commences Thursday May 13th
with a fresh breeze from S & steered N by E
and N N E. At 4 P. M. first Roman Breeze light. Distance
16 Miles. At 1 A. M. first a Breeze standing to the South. Latter
part fresh breeze from S & S E. attended with squalls
and slight showers of rain. the Land in sight Distance 25
Miles. Employed in Ships duty thus ends.
Set by Ob. 6.55 South

Friday May 14th
Commences with a fresh breeze from S & S E. attended
with squalls and heavy showers of rain. Middle part
pleasant. the wind the same. Latter part wind and
weather same as the first, steered N by E and N
Carrying all sail standing with Land a light at sunset
the Land in sight Distance 30 Miles. saw Nothing more
Employed in Ships duty thus ends. No Ob

Saturday May 15th
Commences with a light breeze from S & S E. with thick
breezy looking weather. steered N. all drawing sail
at Middle part more pleasant. Latter part a
fresh breeze from S & S E. and squally with a
plenty of rain. steered N N W and N W by N. all sail
set. saw Nothing. Employed in Ships duty. so ends
Set by Ob. 3.01. South. No Ob

Sunday May 16th
Commences with a fresh breeze from S & S E. and S E
and squally with heavy showers of rain. Middle
and Latter part the same, steered N W by N
carrying all prudent sail. saw Nothing. thus ends
Set by Ob. 1.19. South. No Ob

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Monday May 17th
Commences with a fresh breeze and rain from S & S
10 S & E. with hard squalls heavy showers of rain.
Middle and Latter part buffing winds and squally
with a plenty of rain. steered N N W saw Nothing
Employed making taking in sail and trimming yards
as custom requires, &c. thus ends. No Ob

Tuesday May 18th
Commences with slight buffing winds and squally with
showers of rain. Middle part the same. Ship working to
the N W. Latter part a light breeze from S & S and overcast
steered N N W. saw Nothing. Employed in Ships duty
thus ends. Set by Ob. 2.24. Miles North

Wednesday May 19th
Commences with a light breeze from S & S and overcast
Middle part the same, steered N N W. Latter part
Set light airs and calms with fine pleasant weather
saw Nothing. Employed variously thus ends
Set by Ob. 00.58. Miles North

Thursday May 20th
Commences with a calm and fine weather. Middle
and Latter part a moderate breeze from S & S to East
with heavy showers of rain. saw Nothing but a shoal
of Black Fish round the Ship in the night. Employed
variously thus ends. Set by Ob. 1.25. South. Sailed by there
3418.

Friday May 21st
At three P. M. hours a moderate breeze from East and
fine pleasant weather. steered per Compass N N W
all drawing sail set. saw Nothing. Employed
variously thus ends.
Set by Ob. 5.24. A' Sailed by there 40.20. West
