Saturday June 1st

Commences with a moderate breeze from East, and fine pleasant weather, Middle and Latter part light baffling winds with showers of rain, steered N. N. W. saw Nothing employed in Ships duty thus ends

Sunday June 2^d

Commences with light baffling winds, with showers of rain, Middle and Latter part light winds from N. N. E. to East, with fine pleasant weather, Ship working to the N. W. all drawing sail set, saw Nothing, so ends

Lat by Ob 3, 40. N Long by Chron 41, 31. West

Monday June 3^d

Commences with light winds from N. E. and pleasant Middle part much the same, Latter part squally with heavy showers of rain, N. E. part of A. M. took in the Sturbonian Boat, the Hatch covered, and scraping scrubbing and cleaning her, steered N. N. W. saw Nothing, thus

Tuesday June 4th

Commences with light winds from N. E. and a heavy rain storm, Middle part much the same, steered N. N. W. Latter part Calm and fine pleasant weather employing water by thus ends

Wednesday June 5th

Commences with a Calm, Middle part light baffling winds and squally, Latter a light breeze at E. N. E. and pleasant, steered N. N. W. saw Nothing, employing water by so ends

Lat by Ob 5, 15. N Long by Ob 42, 54. West

Thursday June 6th

Commences with a light breeze at E. N. E. and pleasant Middle part a fresh breeze and squally with a plenty of rain, the wind E. N. E. Latter part much the same steered N. N. W. all forward sail set, saw Nothing employed water by, thus ends

Lat by Ob 6, 34. North Long by Chron 42, 03

Friday June 7th

All three 24 hours fresh breezes from E. N. E. attended with passing squalls, and light showers of rain, steered N. N. W. all drawing sail set, saw Nothing, employing water by, thus ends

Lat by Ob 8, 30. N Long by Ob 45, 29. West

Saturday June 8th

Commences with fresh breezes from E. N. E. and violent with passing squalls, steered N. N. W. Middle and Latter part strong breezes at N. E. and E. N. E. steered N. N. W. by N. all drawing sail set, saw Nothing, employing in Ships duty, thus ends

Lat by Ob 10, 23. N Long by Chron 47, 29. West

Sunday June 9th

All three 24 hours strong trade with passing squalls, steered N. N. W. and N. N. W. by N. employing all forward sail, saw Nothing, thus ends

Lat by Ob 17, 15. N Long by Chron 51, 10. West

Monday June 10th

Commences with fresh trade and fine pleasant weather steering N. N. W. all drawing sail set, Middle and Latter part strong trade with passing squalls steering N. N. W. all drawing sail set, saw Nothing employing in Ships duty, thus ends

Lat by Ob 24, 15. N Long by Chron 50, 32. West
