

Ship Montpelier in the Atlantic Ocean

Thursday June 14th

Commences with strong winds and passing squalls steering N. N. W. all drawing sail set Middle and latter part the same, at 4 A.M. part a Brig steering N. N. W. saw nothing more. Employed mending their sails
Set by 16.30. Long by 57.54. West

Wednesday June 13th

All these 24 hours strong winds with passing squalls and overcast weather, steered per Compass N. N. W. by W. carrying all sail, saw nothing. Employed mending their sails. Set by 16.44. N. Long by 57.18. W.

Thursday June 13th

Commences with moderate trades and fine pleasant weather, one sail in sight, saw gulph weeds, steered N. N. W. by W. all sail set. All hands employed fitting rigging, then ends

Set by 16.09. N. Long by 57.16

Friday June 14th

All these 24 hours light trades and fine weather, saw great quantities of gulph weeds, steered N. W. by N. all sail set. All hands employed fitting rigging, then ends
Set by 16.09. N. Long by 57.27. West

Saturday June 15th

All these 24 hours light winds from E. N. E. and East with fine pleasant weather, steered per Compass N. W. by N. all drawing sail set, saw nothing. All hands employed fitting rigging, then ends

Set by 16.17. N. Long by 56.26.

Sunday June 16th

Commences with light airs and calm, Middle part much the same, latter part a light breeze from E. W. and fine pleasant weather, steered N. W. by N. all sail set, saw nothing, then ends. Set by 16.57. N. Long by 56.47.

Making a Passage from New Bedford June 18, 24.

Monday June 17th

Commences with light airs and calm, Middle and latter part much the same, saw several sail, hauled the Schooner Mary 12 days from New Bern. All hands employed fitting rigging, then ends

Set by 16.01. N. Long by 56.55. West

Tuesday June 18th

Commences with light airs and calm, Middle and latter part a moderate breeze at E. N. E. and fine weather, steered N. W. by N. saw several sail, all hands employed fitting rigging, then ends

Set by 16.00. N. Long by 57.08.

Wednesday June 19th

All these 24 hours a fine breeze from E. N. E. and E. W. with fine pleasant weather, steered N. W. by N. all drawing sail set, saw nothing. All hands employed fitting rigging, then ends

Set by 16.30. N. Long by 58.14.

Thursday June 20th

All these 24 hours light breezes from E. N. E. to N. E. steering N. W. by N. all sail set, saw nothing. Employed mending mattrings, taring down rigging and painting then ends. Set by 17.20. N. Long by 59.58. West

Friday June 21st

All these 24 hours a moderate breeze from N. E. to E. N. E. now and then a passing squall, with a light shower of rain, Middle part had a light tempest steered per Compass N. W. by N. all sail set, saw one sail, then ends

Set by 18.40. N.
