

Ship Montpelier Making a Passage

Saturday June 22nd

All there 24 hours a moderate breeze from S to S by E. and fine pleasant weather, steered N by W by N all sail set, saw one sail, Employed Painting, then ends
Lat by Ob 29, 16, N Long by Obs 62, 06, West

Sunday June 23rd

All there 24 hours light winds from S to S by W with fine pleasant weather, steered N by W by N and N by W all sail set saw two sails, Employed Painting, then ends
Lat by Ob 30, 05, N Long by Sun 63, 28, West
Long by Obs 62, 06, West

Monday June 24th

All there 24 hours light winds from S by W to W by W and fine pleasant weather, steered N by W all sail set, saw nothing, Employed, varnishing, then ends
Lat by Ob 31, 01, N Long by Ob 62, 08, W
Long by Obs 62, 50

Tuesday June 25th

All there 24 hours light variable winds now and then a shower of rain, at 4 A.M. saw Bermuda bearing per Compass N by W, Dist 20 Miles, at 9 A.M. saw White Water, the appearance of a rock, at 10 A.M. discovered a Boat it proved to be a vessel bottom up, a base Pitt Schooner - beneath a haul 80 feet, saw several pairs of hales on one side, she led the appearance of being newly a New vessel at New Providence having ~~per~~ per Compass Dist 10 Miles, Employed in Ship's duty then ends

Wednesday June 26th

All there 24 hours moderate winds and variable with thunder and lightning and showers of rain steered N by W by N all sail set, Employed in Ship's duty, then ends
Lat by Ob 33, 17, N Long by Obs 62, 30

Thursday June 27th

All there 24 hours a fine breeze from S by W and over cast middle part attended with sharp lightning, steered N by W all sail set, at about part a Breeze on the wind heading to the Westward, Employed, varnishing then ends
Lat by Ob 34, 55, N Long by Obs 66, 39, West

Friday June 28th

Commences with a moderate breeze at S by W and fine weather, Middle part latter part much the same at 6 A.M. saw a shoal of Black fish, several fasten to one fish and drove, steered N by W by N all sail set, Employed varnishing, then ends
Lat by Ob 35, 56, N Long by Obs 67, 58

Saturday June 29th

Commences with a brisk breeze at W by W and fine weather, saw 2 sail standing to the S by E. Middle part strong winds, at 12 part 2 A.M. took in the light sails, steered N by W by N at 3 A.M. part a Ship steering East, at 5 A.M. part a Ship steering South from daylight till 10 A.M. experienced a heavy Tempest, and the rain fell in Torrents, the wind shifting from W by W to N by W Ship under two red Topsails, headed N by E, Employed scrubbing Decks then ends
Lat by Obs

Sunday June 30th

Commences with strong winds from W by W and squally weather with a plenty of rain, found the Ship to be in the gulph stream, at 11 P.M. Ship to the North of the Stream, the wind shifted from the S by W to N by W, and then to N by E, at 12 part 8 P.M. took in the headed N by W by N at 10, set the reef out the Top sails, and set the Main Top gallant, Middle part latter part moderate winds from S to S by E, Ship heading to the N by W saw one sail, Employed as usual, then ends
Lat by Ob 38, 09, N Long by Obs 68, 27, West
