Commences with strong gales from S. and thick rainy weather Ship heading S S E under all pendant sail. Middle part variable, latter part light airs and calms. All hands employed merely, saw nothing.

Tuesday Oct 19th

Commences with light airs at S. At 2 PM a squall rose from the S with a tremendous shower of rain. Middle part variable winds and weather, latter part fresh breeze from S S E to S E. Ship heading N E to S E. Evening all pendant sail. All hands employed merely, saw nothing but one sail.

Wednesday Oct 20th

Commences with strong breezes from S S E to S E and squally with light showers of rain. Ship heading N E and S E. All pendant sail set saw nothing. All hands employed merely. Middle and latter part fresh gales at S E to S S E and squally with light showers of rain. Ship heading S E to S. All pendant sail set saw nothing. Employed merely. Franklen Gage sick. Manceur W. Dion sick.

Put by US 37.00 S. No Ch

Thursday Oct 21st

Commences with fresh gales at S S E to S E. Ship heading S to S S E. Middle part and latter part fresh gales at S and squally. Ship heading S S E. All pendant sail set saw nothing. Employed merely. Franklen Gage sick. Manceur W. Dion sick.

Put by US 37.50 Gage at 10 A M of Geo 51.25

Towards The Line 1847

Friday Oct 22nd 1847

Commences with fresh gales at S and hard squalls with showers of rain. Ship heading S S E. All pendant sail set at 7 PM part a shift steering W S W. Middle part more moderates Ship heading S S E, the wind S. Evening all pendant sail. Latter part fresh gales from S to S E with thick weather inclining to rain. Ship heading S S E to S N E under 2 reef. Toprails Fore and Main sail, saw nothing. Employed merely. Franklen Gage sick. A. W. Dion sick. No Ch.

Saturday Oct 23rd

Commences with fresh gales at S E the wind inclining Eastward, with thick rainy weather. Ship heading S E most of the time under two reef. Toprails Fore and Main sail. At 3 PM the gale increasing hauled the Fore and Mizzen Toprails and Main sail. At 4 PM Ware Ship headed S by W. hauled the Fore and Main sail. Close reef the Main Toprail. Middle and latter part hard gales and squalls hauled from S E with a heavy sea. Ship heading South east of the time saw nothing. Franklen Gage sick. A. W. Dion sick. No Ch.

Sunday Oct 24th

Commences with hard gales and squalls hauled from S to S N E, attended with rain. Ship heading S S E to S E under storm sails and laboring hard at that. Middle part the same. Latter part strong squalls at N N W attended with squalls and showers of rain. At 7 A M steered S E & S and made all pendant sail, saw nothing. Franklen Gage sick. A. W. Dion sick.
