heading S & W. saw one sail. Employed
sincerely. Frankling Gage and Hyman & Storkey sick
Put by Chs 20.42. S. Long by Chs 27.26.



Friday Nov 12th

Commenced with a moderate breeze at S & S E
Ship heading S & sail on sight. Middle
and latter part fresh breezes at S. Steered
S and S by E. All sail set saw Nothing Employed
sincerely. Frankling Gage and Hyman & Storkey sick
Put by Chs 17.47. S. Long by Chs 18.41. West

Saturday Nov 13th

Commenced with fresh breezes at S. Steering
S by E. All sail set at 4. part S & S E. Breeze a
way the fly S by E Room. Middle and latter
part fresh breezes at S. by E. Steered S by E to
S & E saw Nothing Employed repairing the
fly S by E Room and S by E. Sick
Put by Chs 16.41. S. Long by Chs 17.28. West

Sunday November 14th

Commenced with fresh breezes at S by E
steering S & E. Breeze all sail. Nothing
in sight. finished the fly S by E Room sent
it out and Brist the sail. Middle and latter
part moderate breezes from S by E to S E
steered S & E saw Nothing. Frankling Gage
and Hyman & Storkey sick
Put by Chs 15.01. S. Long by Chs 16.10. West

Monday 15th

Commenced with a moderate breeze at S E
steering S & E. All sail set Middle and latter
part much the same. Steered S by E saw
Nothing Employed sincerely. Frankling Gage
Put by Chs 13.46. S. Long by Chs 25.30. West

Tuesday Nov 16th

Commenced with a moderate breeze at S by E
steering S by E. All sail set sent the Main
Rag up. Middle and latter part fresh
breezes at S & E and S by E. Steered S by E. saw
Nothing Employed sincerely
Put by Chs 11.38. S. Long by Chs 17.33. West

Wednesday Nov 17th

Commenced with a brisk breeze at S & S E.
steering S by E. At 4. part S & S E. saw a School of Black
Fish. Breeze a good one. at 4 P. M. had a squall
from S & E with Thunder and Lightning and rain
took in all the eight sail. Middle part
variable winds and squally with rain
Ship working the S & all forward sail set
latter part light airs and Calm inclining
to rain squalls. saw Nothing. Employed
sincerely. Frankling Gage sick
Put by a glimpse of the sun 4.57. S. Long

Thursday Nov 18th

Commenced with light airs and Calm inclining
to rain. Middle and latter part strong
breezes from S & E steered S by E saw 2 Ships
Employed sincerely. Frankling Gage sick
Put by Chs 8.10. S. Long by Chs 13.03. West
