Sunday Dec 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fine breeze from N.W. & Ship steering S. All drawing sail set Middle and latter part the same sea Nothing but by the 24, 46. S. Long by Chron 27. 16. West

Monday Dec 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a light breeze from N.W. & steering South. Middle part much the same latter part a fine breeze from N.W. Steer S. Carrying All drawing sail saw Nothing employed repairing the Fore sail.

Lat by the 21. 09. S. Long by Chron 26. 44. West

Tuesday Dec 28<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light breezes from N.W. and overcast, steering S. finished repairing the Fore sail At 2 P.M. shifted the Fore sail and Fore Top sail Middle part light squalls and variable. Latter strong breezes from S. to S.E. with thick rainy weather Ship heading N.W. to S.W. All prudent sail set saw Nothing employed in Ships

Lat by the 32. 16. S.

Wednesday Dec 29<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong winds at 6 P.M. Ship heading S by the 6 P.M. sprung the Fly jib. Boom. Middle part strong winds backing S. & steered S. At daylight sent in the Fly to the Boom and repaired it and sent it out. Latter part a fine breeze from N.E. steered S. Carrying All drawing sail saw Nothing

Lat by the 24. 03. S. Long by Chron 26. 51. West

Towards the South Atlantic Ocean 1827

Thursday Dec 30<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fine breeze from N. steering S. All drawing sail set saw Nothing employed. Middle and latter part fresh breezes at N.W. and overcast, steering S. saw Nothing employed repairing a Main Top sail

Lat by the 35. 27. S. Long by Chron 26. 28. West

Friday Dec 31<sup>st</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze at N.W. steering S. Carrying All drawing sail Nothing in sight. Middle part inclining to hoarse and take in sail as custom required. Latter part strong gales from N.W. and thick rainy weather weather stered S. All prudent sail set

Saturday <sup>January 1</sup> Dec 31<sup>st</sup> 1827

Commences with a hard gale from N.W. with thick rainy weather steering S. under a cover of Main Top sail and Fore sail, Middle and latter part light baffling winds and calm with a rain storm, saw Nothing.

Sunday January 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze from S. Ship heading S.E. Nothing in sight. Middle part the same inclining S.E. At Midnight saw Ship headed S.W. Latter part fresh gales from S.E. & S. Ship heading S.E. & S. All prudent sail set saw Nothing

Lat by the 29. 00. S. Long by Chron 25. 15. West
