Commences with fresh gales from N.W. and overcast steering S by E middle and latter part fresh gales from W to N.W. steering S by E carrying all pendant sail saw nothing. Employed in ships duty.

Wednesday February 21st

Commences with a strong gale from N.W. attended with squalls steering S by E. All pendant sail set, middle part much the same latter part fresh breezes at N.W. saw nothing.

Thursday February 22nd

Commences with fresh gales from N.E. with overcast weather inclining to rain. steering S by E carrying all pendant sail, middle part saw gales and Calms attended with rain ship under short sail. latter part strong gales from N.W. steering S by E saw nothing.

Commences with a fresh breeze from N.W. steering S by E. Carrying all drawing sail Middle and latter part the same saw nothing. Employed scraping Boon.

Saturday February 19th

Commences with a moderate breeze at N.W. steering S by E. Middle part a moderate breeze from N to N.W. latter part fresh gales from E to S.E. with rain ship on the Southern tack under moderate sail.

Sunday February 20th

Commences with hard gales from S.E. to S. ship under storm sails, middle part the same latter part fresh gales from W to N.W. steering S by E carrying all pendant sail saw nothing.

Monday February 21st

Commences with a light breeze from W and overcast. Middle part winds varying from W to N.W. steering S by E. latter part fresh gales from N.W. with thick fog and rain, steered E and S.E. carrying all pendant sail saw nothing.

Lat by a glimpse of the sun 46.24. S Long by Chro 34.07

Tuesday February 22nd

Commences with a brisk breeze at N.W. with thick fog steering S by E. Middle part a fresh breeze from N.W. and pleasant. At 4.30 made Prime & second bearings per compass S.E. distant 80. Miles steered S.E. for the whale Islands, saw 33 Whales.
