Wednesday February 23<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze from N<sup>W</sup> the ship  
close in with the Island saw Nothing At 9 past 1  
P.M. steered E by S. Carrying All pendant sail  
middle and latter part fresh breeze at N. with  
thick fog steered E by S saw Nothing  
Lat by Obs 45.37. S Long by Obs 41.35. E



Thursday February 24<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a light breeze from N by E  
with fine pleasant weather Ship heading  
E by S. middle part variable winds with thick fog  
latter part a fine breeze from N<sup>E</sup> with thick  
fog Ship heading E by S All sail set  
No Obs

Friday February 25<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze from N<sup>E</sup> with  
thick fog Ship heading E by S. middle and latter  
part the same saw Nothing  
Lat by the sun in the fore 45.41. S  
Long in the fore 46.37. E



Saturday February 26<sup>th</sup>

Commences with a fresh breeze from N<sup>E</sup> by E  
Ship heading E by S. All sail set, with thick  
fog, middle part the same. latter part fresh  
gales at N<sup>E</sup> with thick fog and rain,  
No Obs

Sunday February 27<sup>th</sup>

Commences with variable winds with thick  
fog and the rain falling in torrents. middle  
part fresh gales at N. steered E. latter part  
winds at N<sup>E</sup> with squalls and showers of  
rain. saw one sail. At Noon saw one Whale taken  
to no purpose Lat by Obs 45.07. S Long by Obs 51.10. E

Ship Montpelier Bound Eastward 1828  
Monday February 28<sup>th</sup>

Commences with strong gales at N<sup>W</sup> steering  
E by S. Carrying All pendant sail. at 5 P.M. saw  
one or two Whales to my eye to my left middle and latter  
part head gales from N<sup>W</sup> to W with squalls  
harder steered E All pendant sail set saw  
Nothing Lat by Obs 43.30. S Long by Obs 54.37. E

Tuesday February 29<sup>th</sup>

Commences with fresh gales from W steering E by S  
middle part much the same latter part fresh  
gales from N<sup>W</sup> steered E saw Nothing  
Lat by Obs 44.16. S Long by Obs 58.19. E

Wednesday March 1<sup>st</sup>

Commences with strong gales from N<sup>W</sup> and  
equally steering E Carrying All pendant  
middle and latter part head gales from N<sup>W</sup> and  
squalls harder steered E All pendant sail set  
No Obs



Thursday March 2<sup>nd</sup>

Commences with fresh gales from W steering E  
middle and latter part a brisk breeze at W and pleasant  
weather steered E and one sail, employed  
repairing the Main sail,  
Lat by Obs 44.00. S Long by Obs 64.26. W

Friday March 3<sup>rd</sup>

Commences with a light breeze at W steering  
E by S. All drawing sail set finished the  
Main sail and Bent it. middle and latter part  
brisk breezes at W steering E by S. All  
drawing sail set saw one Ship employed  
repairing the Fly Gibb  
Lat by Obs 37.28. S Long by Obs 67.37. E
