

Ship Montpelier At Amsterdam and St Pauls Islands 1848

Saturday March 4th

Commences with a brisk breeze from N.W.
Middle and Patter part much the same time
S by E carrying all down sail, saw one ship
steering S by E. Employed repairing the Tally field
Put by Ch 34.24. S. Long by Ch 70.55.

Sunday March 5th

Commences with a brisk breeze from N.W.
steering S by E. Middle and Patter part fresh
breeze from N.W. to N steering S by E. Carrying
all downing sail one sail in sight
Put by Ch 38.24. Long by Ch 74.24. S.

Monday March 6th

Commences with fresh breezes from N by E steering
S by E. All downing sail set, Middle part the
same. Patter part steers S by E at 10 M. Made
Amsterdam Island bearing per Compass N. by E
Distant 10 Miles the wind N by E blowing strong
saw one chain to gain the Island. At 4 P.M. put 10 S. 16
have a way for St Pauls.

Put by Ch 38.11. S. Long by Ch 77.52. S.



Tuesday March 7th

Commences with strong breezes from N steering
S by W. with thick overcast weather saw nothing
At 5 P.M. haul the ship to the Eastward
middle part variable winds and weather
attended with rain squalls Patter part
light breezes from S to S by E steered S by E. saw
one ship. Employed repairing the Shaker
Put by Ch 38.12. S. Long by Ch 77.23. S.

Wednesday March 8th

Commences with a light breeze from S by E steering
S by N one ship in sight, Middle and Patter part
moderate breezes from S by E. Ship standing on the
bathorn took saw nothing but one sail. Employed
repairing the Migan top gallant sail
Put by Ch 36.53. Long by Ch 81.16. S.

Thursday March 9th

Commences with a light breeze at S. Ship reaching
N. N. E. Middle part calm. Patter part a light
breeze at N steered S. saw nothing. Employed
repairing the Fore sail
Put by Ch 36.24. Long by Ch 84.25. S.

Friday March 10th

Commences with a light breeze at N steering
S. Middle and Patter part brisk breezes at N and
pleasant steered S carrying all downing sail
saw nothing. Employed sail making
Put by Ch Ch 36.02. S. Long by Ch 85.38

Saturday March 11th

Commences with a brisk breeze from N steering
S. Middle and Patter part the same. saw nothing
Employed sail making
Put by Ch 35.27. S. Long by Ch 88.36. S.

Long by Gunner 88.35. S.

Sunday March 12th

Commences with a moderate breeze from N by E
steering S. Middle part the same. saw nothing
Put by Ch 35.16. S. Long by Ch 90.51. S.
