Commenced with a brisk breeze from S^E Ship
heading S^E by S all sail set. Middle part
the same. Latter part a moderate breeze at S.
At 10 A M saw Ship heading S^E & one sail in
sight Employed repairing the Main Toprail

Tuesday March 21st

Commenced with a moderate breeze from S. Middle
