Sunday May 14th

Commences with fresh gale at 8 E under rough at sunset took in sail and more ship headed S by E Middle and latter part much the same saw nothing.

Monday May 15th

Commences with fresh gale at 8 E by S Ship heading S by E. All abundant sail set. saw nothing at sunset shortened sail. Middle and latter part more moderate the daylight made sail and more ship to the S. Nothing in sight. put a new Boat on the Harbour Boat Cairns. Employed repairing the Harbour Boat

Tuesday May 16th

Commences with a light breeze at 8 E by S Ship heading S by E. All sail set. Middle and latter part moderate breeze at 8 E and 8 E 8 Ship heading S by E to S. All sail set saw nothing. Employed in ship duty and repairing the Boat

Lat by Ch 21.58. S Long by Ch 106.25. E

Wednesday May 17th

Commences with a fine breeze at 8 E 8 tucked ship to the S. At 3 P.M. saw a large Breach at sunset took in light sail latter part a brisk breeze at 8 E by S. at 6 A.M. tucked ship headed S by E. At 7 A.M. saw a large Breach. At Noon saw a Whale that we called a sperm Whale going quick to windward. Sawed but saw nothing more of the Whale.
