Commenced with light breezes from E S E Ship heading S W saw Nothing at sunset took in sail and wore ship to the East at daylight made sail heading E by N saw Nothing employed in Ship's duty

Commenced with fresh breezes at E S and overcast weather Ship heading S E saw a school of Black Fish seen saw Nothing more of them at sunset took in sail Middle and Latter part strong breezes and overcast at daylight made All pendant sail saw Nothing

Thursday June 8th

Commenced with a fresh breeze at E S E Ship heading N E saw Black Fish seemed to no purpose took in and made sail as usual saw Nothing employed repairing the Joly Spill

Friday June 9th

Commenced with fine weather steering to the North saw Nothing at sunset took in sail Middle and Latter part variable winds and weather Ship working to the N saw Nothing but Black Fish seemed to no purpose at sunset ~~took in sail~~ Lat by Obs 24.24. Long by Chron 114.03

Saturday June 10th

Commenced with variable winds and weather Ship working to the South saw Black Fish seemed to no purpose at sunset took in sail we had several men complaining of being unwell I had now 5 men of duty and quite a number more complaining and it proved to be the disease middle part Cabin Latter part variable winds Ship working to the S All sail set but a few more top gallant sail
