

Sunday June 11th

Commenced with variable winds and weather
Ship tacking to the N.E. All sail set
Sally employed Bending Studding sails and
getting every thing ready to make a passage
for the nearest Port the first favorable wind
Middle and latter part light winds from N.E. &
to S.W. Steered N.E. by N. All drawing sail at
10 o'clock by the 24.03 South

Monday June 12th

Commenced with light airs and Calm, Middle
part much the same latter part a moderate
breeze from N.W. Ship heading N.E. & N
sail set At 1/2 past 7 A.M. saw the Land
the West Coast of New Holland bearing per
Compass S.E. to S.W. 40 Miles, saw
nothing more except Main Top sails
and employed repairing the Main Top sail
Put by the 23.25 S. Long by 112.06. E
the land out the way 50 Miles 112.56

Tuesday June 13th

Commenced with light baffling airs and Calm
the Land plain in sight from Mast head
Middle part a light breeze at N.W. Ship
heading N.E. at daylight the Land bore
from S.E. to S.W. 25 Miles latter
part a fresh breeze at N.W. At 8 A.M. tacked
Ship to the N. at 9 past 10 A.M. tacked to the
North. Sally in sight but the Land
Put by the 22.57. Long by 112.12
the land out the way 10 Miles 112.22

Wednesday June 14th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from N.W.
Ship heading N.E. At 1/2 past 3 P.M. tacked
Ship to the N. the Land at the time 16 Miles
Distant, Cape Boat bearing per Compass
N.E. by N. At 8 P.M. the wind shifted to South
with a hard squall and the rain fell in
torrents, steered N.W. and shortened sail
down to two reef Top sails and continued
so throughout the night, latter part more
moderate with rainy weather at daylight
made All drawing sail steering N.E.
Sally in sight, employed Working Ship
& Men at duty with the Surge and other
Companys to numbers to mention
No 16 Put by account 21.30 S

Thursday June 15th

Commenced with light airs and sunny
steering N.E. Middle and latter part
fresh breeze from S.E. with thick overcast
weather steering N.E. Carrying All
drawing sail run Sally
Put by windings of the Sun 17.33.8 Long 110.11
by 113.49

Friday June 16th

Commenced with a brisk breeze at S.E.
with a hard run storm steering N.E. by N
Middle and latter part baffling squalls from
all points of the Compass attended hard shows
up rain, saw Sally
No 16 Put by account 17.40 S
