

Sunday June 27th

Commences with a light breeze from
S.W. Ship heading N.E. At sunset the Land
bore for compass N 10 S by S. Dist 30. This
Middle part light winds at S.W. Ship heading
N.E. At midnight tacked Star to the South
At 1/2 M tacked to the N.E. at daylight the Land
in sight from the Deck bearing for compass
S. 1/2 E. to N. 1/2 W. one Ship in sight latter part
light breeze from S.E. by S. Steered S. 1/2 W. to N. W.
for Sunnuck Strait.

Set by Log at 9.10 Put by Log 115.40. S
Put by Log 9.10 Put by Log 115.50. East

Monday June 28th

Commences with a light breeze at S.E. steering
N.W. At sunset the S.W. of Sunnuck bore
for the compass N 1/2 W. and the center of
Band of Island bore W. N. W. Dist 15. This
At 1/2 past of P.M. luffed by the wind headed S.W. by W.
under moderate sail, at daylight steered N.W. by N.
to enter Strait. Nothing in sight but the Land.

Tuesday June 29th

Commences with a light breeze at S.E. steering
N.W. by N. At 1/2 P.M. entered the Straits with light
winds and a strong tide with a flood. At 1/2 past
10 P.M. sounded bell at 33 fathoms. At 11, had
16 fathoms light air and calm at the time. Calm
up every thing and dropped anchor at sunset
At 1/2 got under way with light breeze from
S.E. by S. Ship heading N.E. by E. At 11 A.M. came to
anchor in Sumpuan 16 fathoms. Nothing

Ship Montebello M. Sumpuan July 13th
June 29th. Came to anchor from this time up to
July 17th, we saw had fine pleasant weather
we have been employed cleaning painting
flattering and repairing Ship, July 18th. At 11
P.M. all ready for Sea, At 3 P.M. took the
anchor and steered S.W. At 4 A.M. anchor
in 28 fathoms close to a Island to cut wood

Wednesday July 19th

Commences with fine weather goods at
S.E. All hands employed Wooding

Thursday July 20th

All this day fine weather employed Wooding

Friday July 21st

Commences with a fine breeze from S.E.
At 1 P.M. finished Wooding. At 2 P.M. got
under way and steered out to sea. At sunset
All clear of the Land. Anchors and Chains
stowed and Decks cleared up. Ship heading
S by W. All prudent sail set. Middle and
latter parts fresh breeze from S.E. by E. Ship
heading S by W. All prudent sail set saw
one Ship steering W. Employed variously
Put by Log 7.16 S. Log by Log 115.07. S

Saturday July 22nd

Commences with a brisk breeze at S.E. by E. Ship
heading S by W. Middle and latter parts
much the same, saw nothing employed
variously, Painted the Bow Boat
Put by Log 11.31. S. Log by Log 114.14. S
