to the E. the Land in sight.

Sunday August 27th
Commenced with a calm. Middle part the
same. Gutter part a brisk breeze from S.W.
steered S.E. to S. saw nothing of any account.
Lat by Ob 35.52. S Long by Chron 117 12.18

Monday August 28th
Commenced with a fresh breeze at S.W.
steering S.E. at sunset took in sail. Middle
and Gutter parts fresh breezes from W and
equally with showers of rain saw
nothing but Fimbriata.

Tuesday August 29th
Commenced with fresh breezes at W.S.W.
Ship heading S.W. at sunset took in sail.
Middle part strong wind and squally.
Ship heading S. at daylight made sail.
Nothing in sight steered S.E. to S.W.
Lat by Ob 36.16. S Long by Chron 118.03. E

Wednesday August 30th
Commenced with a moderate breeze from S.W.
steering S.E. at sunset took in sail. Middle
part calm. Gutter part a fresh breeze at
S and equally. Ship heading W.S.W. saw
nothing of any account.
Lat by Ob 35.55. S Long by Chron 118.37. E

Thursday August 31st
Commenced with fresh gales at S. and equally
Middle and Gutter part strong gales with
hard squalls from S.W. to S.W. Ship heading
S.E. to S.E. under storm sails saw nothing.
Lat by Ob 36.16. S Long by Chron 119 05. E

Friday September 1st
Commenced with strong gales with hard
squalls from S.W. Ship under storm sails
heading S.E. Middle and Gutter part the same
saw nothing. Lat by Ob 36.12. S Long by Chron 120.00

Saturday Sept 2nd
Commenced with fresh gales at S.W. inclining
to moderate. Ship heading S.E. under
storm sails at 4 P.M. a School of Black Fish
came round. Landed far from and drove at 5
more Ship to the S.W. and set the Foremast
Middle part the same. Gutter part moderate
moderate at daylight made all foremast sail
heading S.W. saw nothing. Employed
in Ship's duty. Lat by Ob 35.20. S Long by Chron 119 42. E

Sunday Sept 3rd
Commenced with strong winds from W and
saw nothing. Ship heading S.W. under short sail.
Middle part the same. Gutter part moderate
saw nothing. Lat by Ob 35.34. S Long by Chron 119 28. E

Monday Sept 4th
All the 24 hours light wind and equally. Ship
standing on different tacks saw nothing but
Fimbriata. Employed variously.
Lat by Ob 35.13. S Long by Chron 119 23. E
